



Operational Description

Section 1: Hardware Setup

1. Installing Graphic Card into PC

- 1) Turn off power of your computer.
- 2) Undress the cover of your computer by unleashing bolts.
- 3) Check whether AGP Bus Slot is in place or not. If not, it is impossible to install.
Remove and save the screw on the slot cover. You will need it to secure the card in place.
- 4) Hold the card upright by the metal edge, and carefully slide it into the expansion Slot. Gently apply pressure to the upper metal edge only, making sure it snaps into AGP Bus Slot.
- 5) Fasten securely the card into place with the screw that fits into the top notch of the metal bracket.
- 6) Dress the cover of your computer by leashing bolts.
- 7) Connect the Monitor with GARNET TNT2 Ultra Video Connector.
- 8) Turn power on and check whether display is O.K.

Section 2: Software Setup

1. Driver Installation

This section is the explanation on driver installation. Minimum requirements for GARNET GeForce2 MX Twin View be Windows95 OSR2.1 or higher, Windows98, Windows NT4.0 (Server Pack 4), Windows 2000, as O/S. And also, after installing driver, DirectX 7.0a is recommended for correct display.

2. Driver Installation in Windows 9x

GARNET GeForce2 MX Windows 9x driver is operate-able in both Windows 95 and 98. When operating system in your computer is Windows 95 or 98 and you would like to replace only graphic card with our Graphic Card, please review section 2-3 for driver installation. And when you would like to change O/S into Windows 9x after installing GeForce2 MX altogether, please review Section 2-4 for driver installation.

3. When you are to replace existing VGA card with Garnet GeForce2 MX

- 1) When Windows starts, PnP Bios recognized new VGA card and <Add New Hardware Wizard> will come out on screen automatically as below.
Click <Next> in following picture.



- 2) Click <Display a list—you want.> and <Next> in following picture.
 - 3) Click <Have Disk...> in following picture.
 - 4) Click <Browse...> and <OK> in the following picture.
 - 5) Put driver installation CD on your CD-ROM drive and select Win9x Driver and Click <OK> in the following picture.
 - 6) Click <Browse> and <OK> in the following picture.
 - 7) Select Garnet GeForce2 MX and click <OK> in the following picture.
 - 8) Click <Next> in the following picture.
 - 9) Click <Finish> in the following picture.
 - 10) Click <Yes> in the following picture and driver installation is finished, re-starting your computer.
4. When Windows 9x is re-installed after replacing Graphic Card in following picture.
- 1) Click <My Computer> in the <Desktop> and <Control Panel> in the following Picture.
 - 2) Double-click <Control Panel> in the <Display> in the following picture.
 - 3) Click <Display Properties>, <Settings>, and <Advanced...> in the following picture.
 - 4) Click <Adapter> and <Change> in the following picture.
 - 5) Click <Next> at the <Update Device Driver Wizard> in the following picture.
 - 6) Click <Display... want.> and <Next> in the following picture.
 - 7) Click <Have Disk...> in the following picture.
 - 8) Click <Browse...> and <OK> in the following picture.
 - 9) Put driver installation CD, select Win9x driver in the related driver and click <OK> in the following picture.
 - 10) Click <OK> in the following picture.
 - 11) Select Garnet GeForce2 MX and click <OK> in the following picture.
 - 12) Click <next> in the following picture.
 - 13) Click <Finish> in the following picture.
