The public will receive an appropriate description in the marketing literature for the product; they need not acquire it via the application.

These items contain detailed technical specifications on the system and are considered by Invocon, Inc. to be company confidential trade secret data.

This application is directly related to another previous application for the "sister product" of the RDGU which is the CDCU (FCC ID #NJM0919156). That request was granted and the engineer in charge of that application was Mr. Joe Dichoso.
