In the review of your report I had a concern about the measurements tables starting on page 27.

In the tables you list the limit, then the measured reading then the margin. On the right side of the table you then list a correction factor. However, I cannot find anything that says that the measured reading you compared to the limit includes the correction factors. While this is probably the case, and while I may have overlooked the statement, please clarify /verify that the measured readings you use to compare to the limits do in deed include any and all correction factors.
