I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) The label placement photos show labels on both the "street controller" and the "receiver/transmitter". Is this true? It is impossible to read the specific labels on these devices using the photo resolution provided. Moreover, the receiver might not qualify under 15.101 for any FCC ID. Please review this labeling with your client. Regardless, please be advised that if Certification for the "receiver/transmitter" applies it must be under its own unique FCC ID.
- 2.) The Manual on page 1 refers to unknown FCC IDs. Is this the correct manual for this device?
- 3.) The Test Setup photos show the "street controller" along with what appears to be an X-Box console and a TV receiver. My understanding is that current Certification is only sought for the "street controller". Shouldn't this be the only item shown on the turntable during testing?
- 4.) FYI: Test Reports submitted to a TCB should show evidence of accreditation. Please be sure this information appears within your filings.
