>Thuy, I have reviewed the above referenced Class II Permissive Change
>TCB application and have the following items that need to be addressed
>before this review can be completed:

>This Class II Permissive Change (C2PC) application has been filed to
>remove the AMPS mode operation of this handset by software. This FCC
>ID has had an original certification without HAC, a C2PC with HAC
>rating of M4, a C2PC that included HAC rating of M4 and T-Coil rating
>of T4 and a recent C2PC that included HAC rating of M3 (and maybe T4
>also). The cover letter requests that this new model K24-2W0 be granted
>without AMPS mode but including both the HAC RF M-rating and T-Coil
>T-rating. Since the HAC RF M-rating has changed over time, it is
>unclear which version of this handset is being used to eliminate the
>AMPS mode. Is this handset one that has an HAC M3 or M4 rating?

>
>Please confirm that the application submitted under AN06T6277 was
>abandoned and replaced with this above referenced application.

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>The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can
>continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the
