This application is for a Class II permissive change for the Trilithic EASyPLUS Encoder/Decoder FCC ID: P4V-EASYPLUS-1. This device and its associated EASyCAP software packages have been tested for compliance with the OASIS CAP standard, the OASIS IPAWS Profile, and the ECIG CAP EAS Implementation Guide. Pursuant to the FCC 12-7 Fifth Report and Order (EB Docket Number 04-296) adopted January 9, 2012 this application is being made to update the existing certification for the EASyPLUS Encoder/Decoder.


