FCC Software Block Diagram



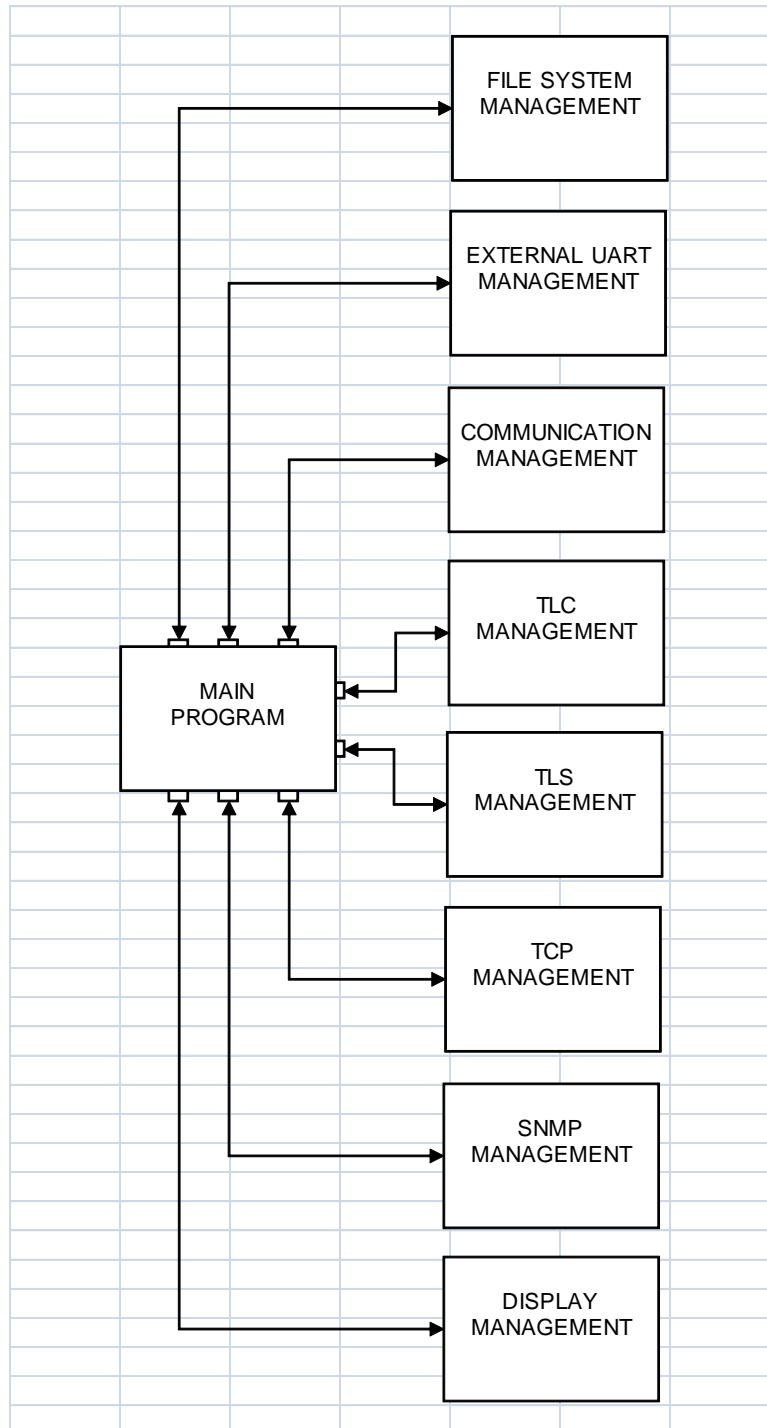

1.3 BLOCK DESCRIPTION

1 MAIN PROGRAM

Initialize the System at the Switch On

By the operative system it manages the tasks hereunder described.

The tasks run all in parallel mode:

- a) FILE SYSTEM MANAGEMENT
 - Management of the configuration files
 - Any save transmitter action creates a file to be saved
 - Any reload transmitter action
 - Any parameters modification transmitter action
- b) EXTERNAL UART MANAGEMENT
 - By a proprietary protocol it manages, via serial line (232 level), all the W/R equipment registers
- c) COMMUNICATION MANAGEMENT
 - Communication management between microprocessor and the function forming the equipment:
 - Up converter
 - Down converter
 - Modulator
- d) TLC MANAGEMENT
 - It manages by the opto (four) the whole equipment
 - RF on/off
 - Remote standby
 - Change mode
 - Alarm reset
- e) TLS MANAGEMENT
 - It manages by the relais (four) the whole equipment
 - RF on/off (or selected alarm)
 - Mode selected (or selected alarm)
 - Alarm defined by web interface mask (two relais)
- f) TCP MANAGEMENT
 - Communication management between microprocessor and web interface:
 - Micro answer to java request
- g) SNMP MANAGEMENT
 - It manages by snmp protocol the following standard SNMP operations
 - Get operation
 - Get next operation
 - Walk operation
 - Set operation
 - Trap
- h) DISPLAY MANAGEMENT
 - By a communication protocol between main micro and display micro it manages the following operations:
 - Menu Navigation
 - Data Settings
 - Data Refresh
