Functional Modes and Features

The MP- 935B2 is a small, lightweight and stylish Portable Bluetooth Player. It incorporates a Bluetooth feature which can stream music or make calls using the MP-935B2. It can support Phone, Stereo or Computer Devices. Other features include a Music Player, Video Player, Phone Book and a FM Player. Powered by a lightweight, rechargeable battery, the MP-935B2 provides hours of audio and video on the move.

A brief description of the features is listed below:



Music Player is a MP3 player and playback's the music files stored in **MP-935B2**. It can also stream music to your Bluetooth stereo headset device. It Support MP3 /WMA / WAV file format.



Video Player playback the video files stored in the **MP-935B2**.



Applications it includes modules in **MP-935B2** like, File Manager, Music Player, Video player, Photo album, EBook, Recorder, FM Radio, Call Records and Phone book.



Bluetooth it support Phone, Stereo audio or Computer Devices on making phone call/answer, Streaming music files or for file transfer with the **MP-935B2**



Settings used to perform all the system settings like set time, date, backlight, volume, language, speaker, key lock, auto power off, check memory status, restore factory setting and show product information in your **MP-935B2**



FM Radio connects to the local FM Radio Stations.




Call Records Consists of all history of the calls made on your **MP-935B2**, so you can call out by the call records by the normal earphone.



Phone Book has the details of the contacts.

Description of the controls



1	ψ	Turn on (press and hold)/ off (press and hold). After the startup is complete, press it to go back to previous menu level
2	Menu	1. Press Menu button Pop-Up the option menu. *2. In the main interface, press to pop the soft key pad. *3. In the main interface, press and hold to enter MIC recorder. In the FM playing, press and hold to enter FM recorder.

3	Vol-	1. Adjust the Volume to lower level. *2. In the date and time setting mode, single click Next is decrease the date & time step by step. *3. Switch between the search list table and the name list table in Phone book.
4	Vol+	1. Adjust the volume to a higher level. *2. In the date and time setting mode, single click Pre is increase the date & time step by step. *3. Switch between the search list table and the name list table in Phone book.
5	Ā	1.To scroll the menu in backward direction and to go up in the menu list *2. In the soft keyboard mode, single click or press and hold Pre button. The flash cursor moved by row mode.
6	▶II	To select or confirm an item.
7	¥	1. To scroll the menu in forward direction and to go down in the menu list *2. In the soft keyboard mode, single click or press and hold Next button. The flash cursor moved by column mode.
8	Reset	Resets the player when you press the reset button with a small pin.
9	MICRO-SD Slot	To hold the MICRO_SD Card

10	Earphone Jack	For connecting the Earphones. Insert the Jack pin until it clicks it the place. You cannot listen to the music if it is not connected properly.
11	USB/Power terminal	To connect the USB terminal to transfer music and video files or to connect the power adopter for charging.
12	Speaker	On the backside of the MP-935B2. To listen to the music without earphone.

Getting Started

Package contents

Your MP-935B2 package includes:

- MP-935B2
- Earphone
- USB Cable
- User Manual

Powering ON your MP-935B2

To Power on your **MP-935B2**, press and hold the Power key.

After the startup is complete, you will see a welcome

screen and then show you the Music Player mode.

Charging your MP-935B2

Your MP-935B2 comes with a rechargeable battery. To charge the battery, you can use the PC USB port to charge your MP-935B2, connect the USB cable to your MP-935B2, then connect the other end of the USB cable to the USB port on your PC. It takes about 4 hours to fully charge up the battery. Or you can buy the AC adaptor (output: 550-750mA) yourself to charge your MP-935B2.

Note: Use the same method above to do the file transfer from PC to your **MP-935B2**; once the PC and the **MP-935B2** have been connected and act as Mass Storage device you can simple transfer file between them.

Music Player

Music Player is a MP3 player and plays back the music files stored in **MP-935B2**. You can download music either from the micro-SD card, through the USB of your PC, or through Bluetooth Devices, like phone, pc or MP3/MP4 player etc. [Support for the micro-SD card up to 2GB]

Listen to the Music Player

Select the Music Player from the main menu. Once you are in the Music Player mode you will be connected to the

last played song. Using the Ξ or Ξ buttons to select the song. To view the pop-up menu, press the **Menu** button. To return to the previous menu at any time press the \Box button.

The pop-up **Menu** contains:

Minimize – Back to the main interface. **Stop** – Stops the music which is being played **Pause** – Pause the music which is being played Play Mode – You have options to repeat the song being played **EQ mode** – you can select the following preset Equalizer modes; Normal, Pop, Rock, Jazz, Classical or custom (Use the **Vol-** / **Vol+** / **₹** / **₹** buttons to do the adjustment for the frequency dB level, and lastly use **III** button to



save the setting and return to the previous menu)

Bluetooth Stereo – Connects to the Bluetooth stereo headset available to listen to music.

Browse – Search for your favorite song according to some preset category.

Exit – Takes you back to the main menu.

To delete a music file, please select Application then go to File manager option and go to the folder where the music file you want to delete was stored. Then press the **Menu** button, this will pop up the delete menu. Select the required option.



Video Player

Video Player plays back the video files stored in **MP-935B2**. You can download video from the PC through USB, the micro-SD card.

Support AVI format, other formats needed to convert into AVI format, and the detail information, please refer to the **"How to translate into AVI format".**

If you download *.AVI file from Internet, and the MP3 player can't support to play, please use the AVI converter tool to convert the file into the corresponding screed size (240*320) and the frame $(\le 15 \text{fps})$ which is supported by MP3 player.

To view the Videos

Select the Video Player from the main menu. Once you are in the Video Player mode you will see the list of video files stored. Use ₹ and the ₹ buttons to highlight the video file you wish to play back and press ►II button to select the video file from menu list.

To pause the video press the **II** button and press the **II** button to start playing again.


To play next video file press the **Next** button

To return to the previous main menu press the \odot button.






To delete a video file, please select Application from main menu, then go to File manager option and go to the folder where the video file you want to delete was stored. Then press the **Menu** button, this will pop up the delete menu. Select the required option.



Applications

Applications let you customize the settings of the **MP-935B2**. Select the Applications from the main menu by pressing the **II** button. It includes the following categories:

File Manager – has the information about the Internal and External memory. It lets you access the file folder for various file types that you can store and access the particular file from there directly.



Music Player- is a MP3 Player please refers to the Music player section for detail.

Video Player - Plays back the video stored in the video player, please refer to the Video player section for details

Photo Album, lets you view photos stored in the **MP-935B2**, please refer to the Photo Album section for details.

EBook – lets you store your favorite EBooks, please refer to the EBook section for details.

Recorder – helps you record music from the FM Radio or from the Microphone and contain the Record List, please refer to the Record section for details.

FM Radio – connects to the local FM radio station, for the details please refer to the FM section.

Call Records – Has the details of the calls, please refer to Call Records section for details.

Phone Book – Contains the list of the contact details, please refer to the Phone Book section for details.

File Manager

The information regarding the Internal and External memory can be found here. Select the File Manager from the Applications menu.

Photo Album

Photo Album lets you view photos, either from micro-SD Card you have inserted into your **MP-935B2**, or from the internal storage it supports JPG fine format. You can also insert photos through Bluetooth Devices. Once in the Photo Album you can get access the pop-up menu by press the **Menu** button, it includes:

Set Caller ID Photo, sets the selected photo in MP-935B2 for a particular Caller ID by selecting the VCard store in the MP-935B2. You can know who is calling you when the Bluetooth phone paired with MP-935B2 has phone calling.

Thumbnail, displays a miniature of the pictures and photo in **MP-935B2**

Property, gives the details like name, size and modify time of the photo file

Set Caller ID Photo:

During viewing the Photo



you can set the particular photo as the Caller ID Photo for particular contact in the phone book. This can be done directly as the screen below when shown the contact person you wish to set to the Caller ID Photo is already in the Phone book contact list else you need firstly to add in the vCard to the phone book as describe in below section.

Once in the Photo Album you can get access the pop-up menu by press the **Menu** button, from the pop-up menu select the Set Caller ID Photo option then you will see the Phone book screen as shown. Press the **II** button to Select the contact in the phone book directly from here to match it to the selected photo that you wish to be the Caller ID Photo for



this contact.(If there is no name list, you need add the contacts first. The contacts support vCard format that is a file format standard for electronic business cards and often attached to electronic phone book e-mail or contacts messages. Add vCard please reference page $\times \times$)

Use the vol- / vol+ / ₹ / ₹ buttons to do the adjustment the cursor, select the name you want. Confirm it.

You will see this screen once you manage to set the particular photo to be the Caller ID Photo to the particular contact in the phone book.





For the case when the phone book list was empty for the start, you need to add the vCard to the phone book before

you can set the particular contact to a photo in the photo album. You can add the vCard as follow:

Enter to Phone Book menu you will see this screen when the phone book list was empty. Press III button to enter the interface of File manager. As following:



Select the option where the vCard was stored, for example select the Internal memory option to get access to the folder where the vCard was stored.



Enter Internal memory interface, select the INBOX folder. Press III button, add the INBOX folder to Phone book, and return the main interface.

Once the vCard is added you can set the Caller ID photo to a particular contact directly from the photo album as describe above, please refer to Set Caller ID Photo section above.



In the Phone book, select a name and click the **Menu** button, it will pop up the interface as the right.



Finish adding VCard file, enter Phone book again. Display as following. Press **vol+** or **vol-** button, switch between search table and name list table. Display as following:



Note: There are two methods to load the vCard into the **MP-935B2**, one is through PC and another is through Bluetooth enable hand phone's phone-book to the **MP-935B2** by Bluetooth connectivity. Please refer to the user manual of the particular hand phone as different phone has different method of operation on this feature.

To delete a photo file, please select Application then go to File manager option and go to the folder where the photo file you want to delete was stored. Then press the **Menu** button, this will pop up the delete menu. Select the required option.

To go back to the previous menu at any time press the button.



EBook

EBook helps to store your favorite books. To access the EBook application, select it from the Applications menu. The EBook supports Txt file format. One enters to the EBook you will be connected to the last page you have read.

To view the pop-up menu presses the **Menu** button.

Go to first page, Jump to the first page.

Back ground picture, Set the back ground picture by your favorite picture.

Front color, Display the font color.

Auto scroll, It can auto scroll the page, when you reading. The auto scroll's speed include: Fast / Middle / Low.



Recorder

To access the recorder, select it from the Applications menu. The categories of the recorder are as below:


FM record, use to record music from the local FM stations in WAV format.

Mic recorder, Use to record voice from the Microphone in WAV format.

Record list, List of the files recorded from FM recorder or Mic recorder in WAV format.

Use ₹ and the ₹ buttons to select the recorded file and press the ►II button to select the recorded WAV file to play back.

To return to the previous menu at any time press the \odot button.



FM Radio

Please refer to the FM radio description.

Call records

Call records contains the records of all the calls made, received and missed ones. Select the call record and press the **Menu** button to access the pop up menu which is as follows:

Delete, removes the selected record.

Delete all the records, removes all the records from the list.

Detailed information, Lists out more information about the calls



Phone Book

Phone Book includes the details of the contacts. To scroll the list of the contacts use the **PRE'** and the 'Next'and **>**II button to select it. Please refer to the Phone Book section for more description.

Bluetooth

Bluetooth specification: Bluetooth 2.0 /EDR, Class 2

The Bluetooth is used different functions here after pairing **MP-935B2** with different Bluetooth Devices:

Phone Devices: Headset & Handfree

(Bluetooth Profile: HSP/HFP)

MP-935B2 is used here to be a Bluetooth Headset pairing with Bluetooth mobile phone. It can let you never miss a call while listening to music, auto pause/resume playing song while there is in-coming call, and dial out function without getting phone out of pocket.

MP-935B2 also provides the call records and phone book for a quick reference to support dialing out function. It also owns the Caller-ID Photo that is the same function as the mobile phone to know who is calling you for great convenience.

Stereo Devices: Audio Streaming

(Bluetooth Profile: A2DP/AVRCP)

The Bluetooth is used here to wireless stream the music from the **MP-935B2** through Bluetooth enabled stereo headset, speaker and car kit etc.

Bluetooth stereo headset is also used to get calls from

your Bluetooth mobile phone when listening to your favorite music in MP-935B2. You can never miss a call when listening to the music.

Bluetooth stereo headset (Supporting AVRCP) is used wireless music remote control to MP-935B2: play, pause, stop, next, and previous.

Note:

- If bluetooth Stereo headset pair with Bluetooth Mobile Phone, and you want to answer a call through bluetooth stereo headset, the MP3 player will stop playing music, After answering the call or end call, the bluetooth headset will receive the music automatically from MP3 player again, and you can use the bluetooth headset to listen to the music in MP3 player again.

Warning: if you want the bluetooth stereo headset can answer the call, the MP3 player can't pair with the bluetooth mobile phone.

Computer Devices/ All Devices: File

Sharing (Bluetooth Profile: OPP)

The Bluetooth is used here to share digital contents (song, video, photo, e-book, document, and vCard etc.) between Bluetooth enabled devices like Lap-top, PC, mobile phone,

and other Bluetooth media player etc.


Access the Bluetooth mode use using ₹ and ₹ buttons to select it and then press the ►II button to enter to Bluetooth mode from the main menu. Once you are in the Bluetooth mode, you will get the menu as shown below.

Activated, turn on and off your Bluetooth

My Devices lists the categories you can search.

Visible, will show the visibility of the Bluetooth.

My Device name shows the name of the device



Pairing the MP-935B2 with the Bluetooth

Devices

Activated the Bluetooth; in the **MP-935B2** and the Bluetooth Devices (Please refer to the user guide of your Bluetooth Devices and turn on to pair mode). Then select the **My Devices** and you will see the options listed below.

Phone Devices will search for the new phone devices enabled with Bluetooth.

Stereo Devices, will look for the stereo devices enabled with Bluetooth

Computer Devices will look for the Computer devices with Bluetooth enabled

All Devices, will look for the devices which are Bluetooth enabled



Go to **All Devices**, and select **search new device** in the next menu screen. This will list out the devices available. Next choose the device that you wish to pair to by using ₹ and ₹ buttons to highlight it and then press the ►II button to select it. This will prompt you if you want to pair with the selected device as seen below:

Press the **II** button to confirm the pairing with the device (Bluetooth headset or Mobile phone) found.



This will ask you for the password to be entered. To scroll the numbers row wise press the **PRE** and to move column wise press **NEXT** button. Now it will list the name of the headset that is paired. Finish pairing, should be connected each other.

Note:

Pairing Phone Devices: MP-935B2 and Phone Devices should be both keyed in the same password with 4 numbers, like 8888.



Pairing Stereo Devices: MP-935B2 should be keyed in the password of your Stereo Devices.

Pairing others: It depends on Bluetooth Devices. Please refer to the user guide of your devices.

The password of MP-935B2 is 8888.

The password of i.Tech Clip R35 is 8888 (i.Tech Clip R35 is the example for the Bluetooth headset).

After pairing successful, connect with the phone device. If connect is successful, the icon of Bluetooth in the inform bar is changed for.



After pairing successful, connect with the stereo device. If connect is successful, the icon of Bluetooth in the inform bar is changed for .



How to use MP-935B2 paired with Phone

Devices

Dial Mode

Now that the Pairing is done with your Bluetooth Phone Devices (Mobile Phone with HS/HF Profile) you can also use it to dial, and to receive phone calls and talk over your **MP-935B2** (Bluetooth Headset).

Types of dial mode

You can use the **MP-935B2** to make a call in three ways; Dial directly, Dial by phonebook, and Dial by the track record. All the three Dialing modes are explained below;

Dial directly

From the main menu of the **MP-935B2**, press the **MENU** button, you will get the soft keypad as seen below.

Enter the phone number you wish to call. To scroll the numbers row wise press the **Next** and to move column wise press **PRE.** To dial the number entered select the Call key and press the **>II** button

To stop the call made press the \odot button.



Dial by Phonebook

From the main menu select the Phone Book application. Once in the Phone Book, it will list the details of the contacts available. To scroll the name list use the **Next** or **PRE** buttons. To call the highlighted button, press the button. To end or cancel the call, press the button.

Dial by Call Record

From the main menu select the Call Record application. The Call record lists the details of the calls. To scroll the name list use the **Next** or **PRE** buttons. To call the highlighted button, press the **II** button. To end or cancel the call, press the **U** button.

In all the three dialing modes, in between a conversation, press the **MENU** button to get the below pop-up menu;

Dial Last Number— Dial the last number of record list.

End Call— this will disconnect the call.

Mute– This will mute the volume

Audio Transfer to AG—Switch to hand-phone.

DTMF Input— When you need input the number for extend phone or get prompting message. Select it.

Dial Key board, this will pop-up the soft keypad



How to use MP-935B2 paired with

Bluetooth stereo headset

Now to connect to the Bluetooth stereo follow the steps

listed below:

When you are listen the music, click the **MENU** button and you will get a pop-up menu as seen in the screenshot. Select the **Bluetooth stereo** by using ₹ and ₹ buttons to highlight it and then press the ►II button.



Select the Bluetooth stereo headset that you want to stream the music to.



For the case, there is no stereo device, enter this interface. You need to search new stereo devices. If there is a stereo device paired, you can connect it directly.



The pairing process is same as up description. Then input the pairing code and connect.



It will be connect and start streaming the music from the **MP-935B2** to the Bluetooth headset.



How to use MP-935B2 for file sharing

Now to connect to the Bluetooth enabled Devices; like Mobile Phones, PC or Laptop with OPP to transfer MP3, JPEG photo files (OPP Profile) please follow the steps listed below:

Object Push Profile (OPP)

The MP-935B2 can also be used to transfer MP3, JPEG photo files using the Bluetooth enabled Devices, like Mobile Phones, PC or Laptop. To do this, first the

Bluetooth device has to be paired with the **MP-935B2**. To perform this, follow the steps below:

Turn on the Bluetooth of both the Mobile phones and the MP-935B2.

Once the file is selected from the mobile phone that has to be transferred, go to the menu of it and select the **send via Bluetooth** (This depends on the device you are using for the OPP/file transfer);

The file will be send to the **MP-935B2** once it accepts the prompt.

The file will be saved in the **Inbox** folder of the File Manager under Application section from main menu (See below section).



The transfer can also be done from **MP-935B2** to the Mobile phone or other devices that are Bluetooth OPP

Profile enabled.

Go to **Application** from the main menu, select the **File Manager** option then select the memory location where the MP3 file is stored.



Select the Internal Memory option, and select the folder where the Mp3 music was stored. Highlight the Mp3 file (other files) that you want to transfer to the Mobile Phone that you have already paired and connected to. Press and Hold the Menu button, a pop up menu will appear and select the **Send via Bluetooth** option from it.



Lastly, a **More Device** pop menu will show when the device is connected via Bluetooth. Select the device to which the highlighted file should be transferred.

Once you have selected the device name, the device will be notified, that the file is going to send to the device and whether it wants to accept or cancel. If the device accepts it, the file will start transfer from the MP-935B2 to the device selected above.



Settings

Settings lets customize the settings of your **MP-935B2.** Select the **Settings** from the main menu and you will see the settings menu. It includes the following categories:

Time and date – Allows you set the time and date.

Backlight - Allows you set the duration the backlight should be switched on.

Music volume – Allows you to adjust the volume of the music Voice volume – Allows you to adjust the voice volume


Language – Used to select the desired language.

Memory status – Has information regarding the usage of the memory

Key lock – Helps to lock or unlock the keypad

Restore factory settings – Allows you to restore the factory settings

Product information – Contains the information regarding the MP-935B2, like the software version, Bluetooth address, product model name and produced date.



Note:

Adjust the music volume & Voice volume is not influence each other.

Set **Time and date** as following:

Mode – Consists of two kind modes (12H/24H).

The special operate:

Settings interface operating describe as following.

vol+: Press **vol+** button to increase the number.

voi-: Press **voi-** button to decrease the number.

₹: Press ₹ button to skip previous item.

Φ: Press Φ button to return. Press and hold it to be powered off.

₹: Press ₹ button to skip previous item.

▶II: Press ▶II button to save time and date value and then return to settings interface.



FM Radio

FM Radio automatically tunes to the available FM Station when selected. To view the pop up menu press the **Menu** button. You will see a screen as below;

Minimize – Back to the main interface.

Channel list – lists the channels available.

Fine – Allows you to fine tune the channel

Auto search channel – Searches the channel automatically.

FM region – Select the desired region.

FM sensitivity – Shows how sensitive the FM is

Exit – Exits from the FM Radio



Fine

This is used to fine tune the selected channel. To Fine

tune the channel use the **'PRE'** and **'Next**' buttons. Then press the **Menu** button to save the fine tuned channel.

Call Records

Call records contains the records of all the calls made, received and missed ones. Select the call record and press the **Menu** button to access the pop up menu which is as follows:

Delete, removes the selected record.

Delete all the records, removes all the records from the list.

Note:

If you want to save the call records into phone book, you need to save them from your mobile phone first and transfer the contacts (vCard) to phone book in MP-935B2 by file sharing of Bluetooth function.



Phone Book

Phone Book includes the details of all the contacts. Using the Bluetooth device that you are connected you can also

access the phone book to call.

To scroll the list of the contacts use the 'PRE', 'Next' and > button to make the call.

Note: If your phone book is empty, then you need to add the vCard to MP-935B2 to get the contact list, please see the section, Set Caller ID Photo above on how to add the vCard to the MP-935B2 so to get the contact list under the phone book.(Page 18)

Finish adding VCard file, enter Phone book again. Display as following. Press **vol+** or **vol-** button, switch between search table and name list table.

Once your phone book is not empty then you can make a call by select the name from the list, then press II button to pop up the interface as


shown. You can call out directly now by press ►II button.

How to use the bluetooth to send the

- 1. Select one contact in your mobile, and then go to bluebooth mode to send the contact message to MP-935B2.
- 2. When the MP3 player prompt "Receive data from xxx" (xxx means the mobile model), and press ►II button to receive the data from the mobile, then press ►II button again to add the contact message to the Phone book mode directly.
- 3. Users can go to the Phone book mode to view the contact which you send.
- 4.
