I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Please indicate where I can find the required labeling of 15.19(a)(1). This rule specifies that...
"Receivers associated with the operation of a licensed radio service, e.g., FM broadcast under part 73 of this chapter, land mobile operation under part 90, etc., shall bear the following statement in a conspicuous location on the device:

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the condition that this device does not cause harmful interference."

- 2.) FYI: All Part 22H transceivers are required to show the power in terms of ERP. For this case the maximum measured ERP will be shown on the Grant of 0.201W.
- 3.) FYI: The correct equipment code for Part 22H only Cellphones is TNE. Only Part 24 PCS or Part 22/24 dual band phones receive the equipment code PCE.
- 4.) I see the Tune-Up procedure provides for a maximum power of +24.5dBm. However, I see nothing to indicate the target power tolerance during manufacturing. Kindly provide some indication as to the expected power variance to be expected during manufacturing.
