I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Since there is no legally specified channelization used for GSM, GPRS, HSDPA, etc., your Form 731 must show the expected frequency range listed from the center frequency of the lowest fundamental to the center frequency of the highest fundamental for all requested emission designators. In addition, please provide emission designators for all requested emissions (GSM, GPRS, WCDMA, etc.). It appears that you are requesting more than simply 300KGXW and 5M0F9W. Kindly review and correct your application form, or provide written justification for why 300KGXW and 5M0F9W should be sufficient.
- 2.) Please correct the client statement to include which issue of HSDPA is supported by this device. In addition, the contact window listed at the FCC website is Zhang Xinghai. This matches both the Agent Authorization and Confidentiality Request letters, however, the client statement is signed by Kang Ying. Under what authority does Kang Ying speak for Huawei?
- 3.) This device connects to a computer. Consequently this can also be considered a Class B Computer Peripheral under Rule 15.101. How is this additional equipment authorization being handled – as a Certification or DofC?
