Thank you for your inquiry - FCC is continuing to investigate and update measurement and TCB review & approval procedures for 3G devices, and plans to circulate revised versions soon. Meanwhile, please ensure TCB filings are consistent with guidance in attached.

Concerning mobile or SAR: Desktop units generally are considered mobile devices and should be handled accordingly. However, 2.1091 d4 may be applicable in this case and SAR evaluation may be justified. TCBs are allowed to review such SAR reports.
