




OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS


Slide the ON / OFF switch to "ON" position at bottom of vehicle.

1 X 9-VOLT BATTERY

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

REMOVE BATTERY COVER. INSTALL 6 "AA" SIZE BATTERIES (FOR VEHICLE) AND 1 "9 VOLT" SIZE BATTERY (FOR RADIO CONTROL) (BATTERIES ARE NOT INCLUDED)

- DO NOT MIX OLD AND NEW BATTERIES
- DO NOT MIX ALKALINE, STANDARD (CARBON-ZINC) OR RECHARGEABLE (NICKEL-CADMIUM) BATTERIES
- BATTERIES ARE TO BE INSERTED WITH CORRECT POLARITY
