



Battery

Before you use it for the first time, the LZ380B must be fully charged. To do this, connect LZ380B to your computer via the USB to micro-USB cable. The indicator on the side of the right ear cup illuminates with a red light to show that the device is charging.

Once charging is complete, the indicator light turns off (1).



When the battery is flat, you can still use the LZ380B to listen to music if your audio player is connected to the headset via the Jack to Jack cable. Conversely, the telephone and Bluetooth music transfer functions and touch sensitive panel are not available (2).

Switching the LZ380B on/off

Press the button (1) to switch the product on/off.

Wearing the headset

Adjust the band without forcing it, so that the headphones will fit comfortably over your ears, then put the headset on, using the letters (L) and (R) to help you distinguish left and right.

Bluetooth Connection

Before LZ380B can be used with your telephone or Bluetooth audio player, the two devices must be paired(3). Once the two devices have detected each other, it is no longer necessary to pair each time.

- From your telephone or Bluetooth audio player, start a search for Bluetooth peripherals.
- 2. Select LZ380B

Once your telephone is paired with the LZ380B , the two devices will connect to each other automatically each time that the LZ380 is switched on. It is not possible to simultaneously connect several devices to LZ380B

Music

Note: The touch sensitive panel is located on the right speaker. Connect the LZ380B to the audio source

- Connect the Jack to Jack cable supplied to the LZ380B's right headphone and connect the other end to your audio player.
- If your telephone/Bluetooth audio player supports Bluetooth A2DP, you can also send music to your LZ380B via Bluetooth.

Volume/Using during a call (4)


To increase the volume, swipe your finger upward and pause one second on the touch sensitive panel.

To decrease the volume, swipe your finger downward and pause one second on the touch sensitive panel.

Next/Previous (5)

If your audio player is connected to the LZ380B via Bluetooth: To return to the previous track, swipe your finger backward on the touch sensitive panel.

To move to the next track, swipe your finger forward on the touch sensitive panel.



Analog Volume Control

Easy to use volume control dial to turn your volume up & down. simply push the knob up turn the volume up and push the knob down to turn the volume down.

Pause/Play

Press the power button to pause and play music.

Telephone

Press the power button to answer the phone call. Press the power button again to end the phone call. Press the power button twice to call the last number in your phone call records.



Warning
