RE: Confidentiality Request for NexPod Model FCC ID RL7-SKU102-001-0A

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter serves as an official request for confidentiality under FCC Rule Section 0.459. We have requested that the schematics, description of internal operation, block diagrams, internal pictures and including:

1. MEA Deployment and Users Guide.pdf
2. Installation Guide NA NR ver 2.pdf
3. Deployment Guide.pdf

All are required to be submitted with the application be withheld from public review. This documentation is included in an Intellectual Property agreement with MESH Networks and should these documents be made available to the public NexGen City (NGC) would be substantially in violation of that agreement.

NGC customers are Municipalities who are purchasing broadband communications systems for "First Responders". The general public does not have access to product documentation. The cities are required to sign a Non-Disclosure agreement relating to all documentation. This agreement protects both the IP inherent in the equipment and improves the wireless network communication security.

The NexPod Model # RL7-SKU102-001-0A is sealed and should the seal be broken the unit warrantee is rendered invalid. The product is designed for factory service and repair only. NGC purchased manufacturing rights for the MESH Networks transceiver and through contract requirements NGC is obligated to maintain the confidentiality of the significant intellectual property. It is NGC's desire that none of this documentation get into the hands of the competition.

The MESH transceiver is used in conjunction with other electronics to build a wireless router operating in the ISM band.
