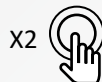


Power Button/Audio Profiles Switcher/Pause and Play Button



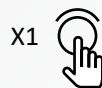
Press for 2 seconds:

Blue LED blinking or "Power on" voice prompt means power on;
Red LED blinking or "Power off" means power off.



Double Click:

Cycle through Gaming mode, Music mode, and Theater mode to switch sound effects.



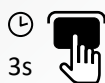
Click:

Press once to pause and again to resume.

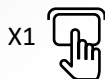


Microphone Mute Switch/ENC On/Off

Press for 3 seconds: ENC on / off

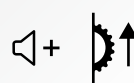


Click: Microphone on / off

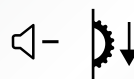

Volume Control Knob



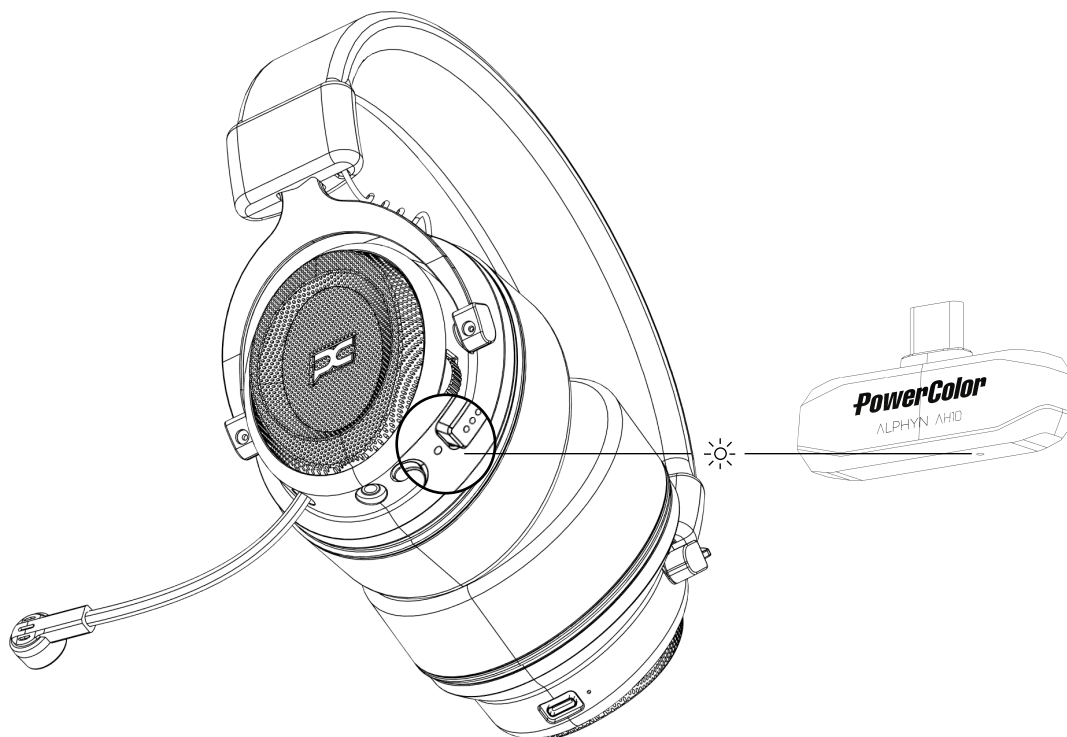
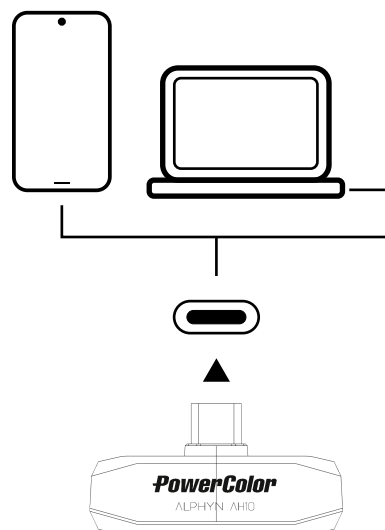
Scroll upward: Volume +

2.4 GHz Transmitter Connection

1. Insert the 2.4 GHz transmitter into the TYPE-C ports of your computer, phone, and other devices. The adapter will automatically start up and the blue LED flashes to enter the pairing state.
2. Turn on the headset, and the headset and adapter will be automatically connected successfully.
3. After successful connection, the indicator light will flash blue every three seconds.

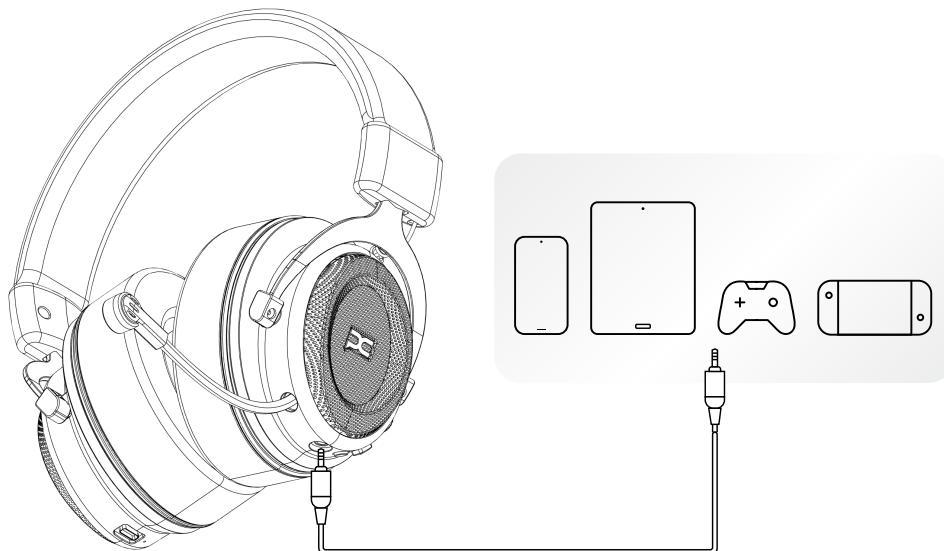


Note :

1. If pairing or connection with the headphones is not successful within 1 minute, the transmitter will enter standby mode until reconnected successfully or powered off. In standby mode, the blue status indicator light will flash once per second.
2. If it's unable to complete automatic pairing, you can enter the re-pairing mode by pressing and holding the power button for about 4 seconds while the device is powered off.

3.5mm Wired Connection

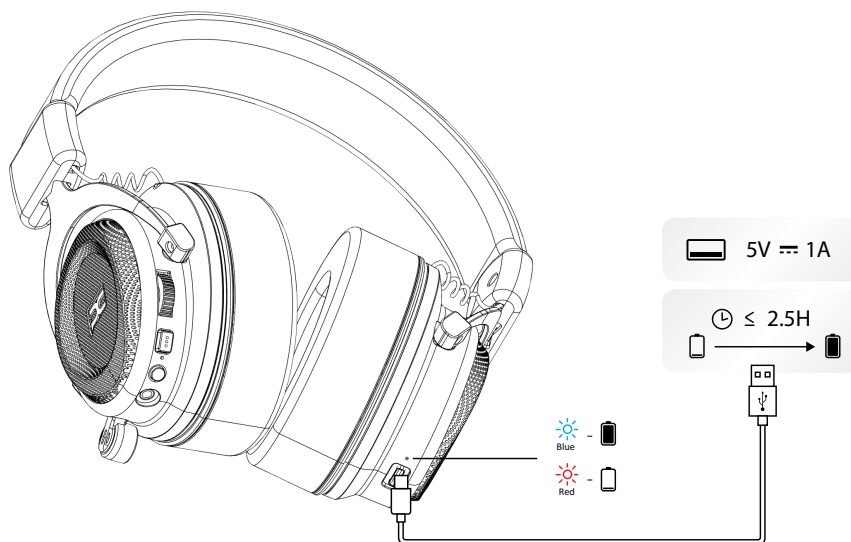
Insert the 3.5 mm audio cable into the headphone's audio jack, and connect the other end to your computer, phone, and other devices.



Note :

In 3.5 mm mode, the headphones will enter a forced power-off state, rendering the microphone mute function inactive. However, you can still adjust the volume using the Volume Control Knob, and charging is possible while in 3.5 mm mode.

Headset Charging Mode



1. When the headphone battery drops below 3.3V, it will voice prompt "Low Battery" every 3 minutes, with the red light blinking every second. When the battery level falls below 3.2V, it will automatically power off.
2. Insert the USB Type-C charging cable to charge the headset. It will reset, automatically turn off, and enter charging mode. The red light indicates charging and turns off when fully charged.

Note :

In charging mode, the headphones will forcibly power off but can still be used in 3.5 mm mode.

Warranty

1-Year Limited Manufacturer Warranty

Warranty does not cover damages resulting from improper use.

Safety and Maintenance

Do not take apart the device or operate it under abnormal currents load, any damage caused when doing so will void your warranty. Keep the device away from liquid, humidity or moisture.

Cleaning the device and connecting port regularly helps to keep it in optimum condition. Use a soft cloth and do not use soap then cleaning the device.
