

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE PLAYING AND RETAIN THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

RADIO CONTROL FREQUENCY

For interference-free results, do not operate this vehicle with other radio-controlled toys not included in this set within transmission range.

TRANSMITTER AND RECEIVER

Since radio waves control this vehicle and in order to avoid interruption, do not operate this vehicle near electrical or telephone lines, CB interference, CD players, mobile phones, elevators, steel girders, other electronic devices and near highways.

INSTALLING THE BATTERIES

- Remember to set the "ON-OFF" switch at bottom of the vehicle to "OFF" position before inserting the batteries.
- Unscrew battery compartment cover to insert batteries in the vehicle as shown in diagram. Make sure all batteries are at the correct polarity.
- Close the cover and tighten the screw.
- To insert battery in the controller, open battery compartment cover to insert battery as shown in diagram.
- Close the cover.
- Do not leave batteries in the vehicle and transmitter when the toy is not in use.
- Do not mix old and new batteries together.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Remove used batteries from the toy.
- To prevent supply terminal are short-circuit, keep battery compartment free of all materials except batteries.
- For best performance, alkaline batteries are recommended.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire, Batteries may explode or leak.
- Batteries contain mercury, don't put in trash, Recycle or dispose as hazardous waste.

OPERATING THE VEHICLE

- For your safety, never play with this toy on the street.
- Turn the "ON-OFF" switch at the bottom of the vehicle to "ON" position, then the vehicle will be idle.
- Pull the trigger downward on the transmitter, the vehicle will respond in going forward.
- Release the trigger, the vehicle will stop.
- Push the trigger upward on the transmitter, the vehicle will turn in reverse.

OPERATION TIPS

- Operate only on smooth (but not slippery), dry and clean surface.
- Do not play with this toy on grass, sand or carpet.
- Do not drive the toy through water.
- Always point the controller antenna upward for better transmission.
- Do not make any physical contact with the controller antenna while operating.
- Keep the toy in a dry and cool place after playing. Do not leave it directly under sunlight.

RADIOFRECUENCIA

Para evitar interferencias, no utilice este juguete con otros juguetes con radiocntrles que no se incluyen con este juego al alcance de la transmisi3n.

TRANSMISOR Y RECEPTOR

No utilice este juguete cerca de postes el6ctricos o telef3nicos, interferencia BC, lecturas de CD, tel6fonos celulares, elevadores, vigas de acero, otros dispositivos electr3nicos o autopistas ya que las ondas de radio controlan este veh6culo.

INSTALACI3N DE LAS PILAS

- Acu6rdese en apagar el interruptor antes de insertar las pilas.
- Abra la cubierta del compartimiento de pilas para insertar las pilas como se muestra en el diagrama. Aseg6rese que todas las pilas est3n con la polaridad correcta.
- Cierre la cubierta y apriete el tornillo.
- Para insertar la pila en el controlador, abra la cubierta del compartimiento de pilas y la inserte como se muestra en el diagrama.
- Cierre la tapa.
- No deje las pilas en el veh6culo y transmisor cuando no use el juguete.
- No mezcle pilas viejas y nuevas.
- No mezcle pilas alcalinas, est3ndar (carbono-zinc) o pilas recargables (n6quel-cadmio).
- Las pilas no recargables no deben recargarse.
- Retire las pilas usadas.
- Para evitar de ponerse las terminales en corto, mantenga el compartimiento de pilas libre de todos materiales excepto las pilas.
- Para mejor rendimiento, se recomienda usar pilas alcalinas.
- No deseches las pilas en el fuego. Las pilas pueden explotar o tener fugas.
- Las pilas contienen mercurio. No las coloque en la basura. Reciclela o man6jela como desperdicio peligroso.

PARA USAR EL VEH6CULO

- Para su seguridad, nunca juega con este juguete en la calle.
- Coloque el interruptor de ENCENDIDO/APAGADO (ON/OFF) en "ON" y despu6s el veh6culo marcha al ralenti.
- Oprima el gatillo abajo en el transmisor y el veh6culo va adelante.
- Suelte el gatillo y el veh6culo para.
- Oprima el gatillo arriba en el transmisor y el veh6culo vuelva en reverso.

CONSEJOS DE OPERACI3N

- Utilice s3lo en superficies suaves (pero no resbalosas), secas y limpias.
- No juega con este juguete sobre el pasto, arena o alfombras.
- No lo use en agua.
- Siempre apuntar arriba la antena del controlador para mejor transmisi3n.
- Evite el contacto con la antena del controlador mientras opere el juguete.
- Mant6ngalo en un lugar fresco y seco despu6s de jugar. No lo dejes en sol directo.

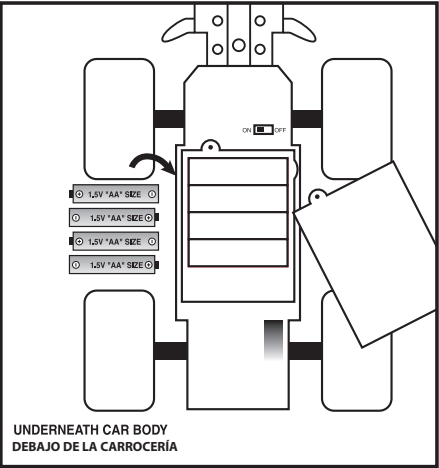
