I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Kindly supply a proposed Label for this device and indicate its proposed placement on this device.
- 2.) FCC rules require Test Setup Photos to be supplied as a separate Exhibit. Please supply Test Setup Photos.
- 3.) In addition to the Schematics, all Part 15 devices must supply a Block Diagram. Please provide a Block Diagram for this device.
- 4.) FCC Rules require a loop antenna be used for measurements below 30MHz. An antenna is identified as "A_00031" in the Test Report, but there is no reference to this antenna in the equipment list. Was a loop antenna used in measurements below 30MHz?
- 5.) The Operational Description is insufficient. Ideally, this should be a functional description of the circuit describing how it generates, modulates, and uses radio frequency energy. Please provide a more complete Operational Description.
- 6.) The External and Internal photographs are unusually small. FCC rules expect that photos should be one-to-a-page, and of sufficient clarity to read any designators on the printed wiring boards. Kindly supply larger photographs.
