

② LED indicator



Quick start:

BT connection

Press & hold Power Button for 3 seconds, headset notification sound: “Power on, pairing”, turn on your device Bluetooth function and searching for device “H610”, select the device name, when connection accomplished the headset notification sound: “connected”.

Wired connection

Connect the headset and audio device with a 3.5mm audio cable.

Power save mode & How to charge:

Power save mode

When the headset is un-connected for over 10 minutes, the headset will turn off automatically. When the headset is connected, over 10 minutes no audio play or no operating, the headset will turn off automatically. (If ANC is activated, the headset will keep working even if there is no audio play)

How to charge

When the battery is low, the headset notification sound: “low battery”, and the LED indicator will flash in RED.

Use TYPE C -USB cable to charge the headset by connecting to PC USB port or DC 5V charger.

When charging, the LED indicator is steady on RED.

Storage
