Dear Christine Taylor,

Concerning the GoRadio pending FCC approval:

The Transmitter cannot go into "configuration mode" as mentioned in the manual. It is not possible for the purchaser/dealer/end user to switch to the configuration mode. To do so requires a special connector cable (connected to programming equipment) to be installed at the factory for programming/configuring. This connection cannot be made with the batteries installed. When configuring the transmitter at the factory, a particular pushbutton is pressed when the configuration/programming equipment is powered up, thus allowing the programming equipment to configure the functionality of the transmitter but not the RF output.

We are removing from the manual the statement "Do not press any buttons while installing batteries. Pushing certain button combinations "may" cause the unit to go into factory configuration mode. This would be indicated if the LED toggles rapidly from GREEN to RED. If this happens, remove the batteries and re-install them correctly."

We are replacing it with the following:

"Verify no pushbuttons are pressed while installing the batteries. If a pushbutton is pressed while installing the batteries, the transmitter LED will flash RED continuously until the batteries are removed and then re-installed. If this problem continues, return the transmitter to the factory for repair."
