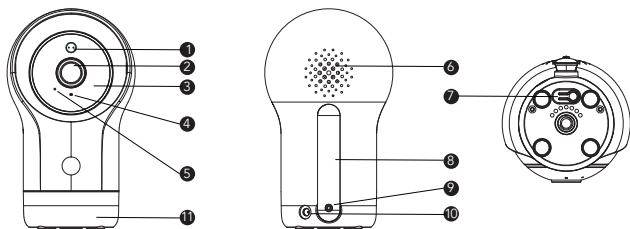

Important guidelines for installing your Nursery Pal Glow

- The signal strength may also be reduced by other solid structures, like walls, or by radio or electrical equipment, such as TVs, computers, cordless or mobile phones, fluorescent lights or dimmer switches.
- Other 2.4GHz products, such as wireless networks (Wi-Fi® routers), Bluetooth™ systems, microwave ovens or other Baby Monitors, may cause interference with this product, so keep the Baby Monitor at least 5ft (1.5m) away from these types of product, or switch them off if they appear to be causing interference.
- If the signal is weak, try moving the Parent and/or the Smart HD Baby Monitor to different positions in the rooms.

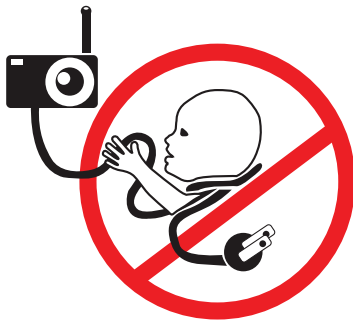

1. Safety Instructions

WARNING:

Strangulation Hazard: Children have **STRANGLED** in cords. Keep this cord out of the reach of children (more than 3ft (1m) away). Never use extension cords with AC Adapters. Only use the AC Adapters provided.



Smart HD Baby Monitor SET UP & USE:

- Choose a location for the Smart HD Baby Monitor that will provide the best view of your baby in their crib.
- Place the Smart HD Baby Monitor on a flat surface, such as a dresser, desk, or shelf or mount the Unit securely using the Flexible Grip or Tripod mount screw hole on the underside of the stand.
- NEVER place the Smart HD Baby Monitor or cords in the crib or within reach of the baby (the unit and cords should be more than 3 feet away).

WARNING

This Smart HD Baby Monitor is compliant with all relevant standards regarding electromagnetic fields and is, when handled as described in the User's Guide, safe to use. Therefore, always read the instructions in this User's Guide carefully before using the device.

- Adult assembly is required. Keep small parts away from children when assembling.
- This product is not a toy. Do not allow children to play with it.
- This Baby Monitor is not a substitute for responsible adult supervision.
- Keep this User's Guide for future reference.
- Do not place the Smart HD Baby Monitor or cords in the crib or within reach of the baby (the unit and cords should be more than 3 feet away).
- Keep the cords out of reach of children.
- Do not cover the Baby Monitor with a towel, blanket, or other item that will stop air circulation.
- Never use extension cords with power adapters. Only use the power adapters provided.
- Test this monitor and all its functions so that you are familiar with it prior to actual use.

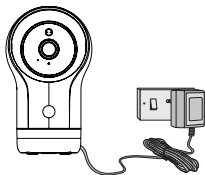


- Do not use the Baby Monitor near water or allow water or other foreign substances to enter the power port or adapter.
- Do not place the Baby Monitor near a heat source.
- Only use the chargers and power adapters provided. Do not use other chargers or power adapters as this may damage the device and battery packs.
- Do not touch the plug contacts with sharp or metal objects.
- The Unit should be set up and used so that parts of the user's body other than the hands are maintained at a distance of approximately 8 inches (20 cm) or more.



2. Getting Started

2.1 Connecting the Power Supply of the Smart HD Baby Monitor



- Connect the mains power to the Smart HD Baby Monitor and the other end to a suitable electrical outlet.
- Only use the enclosed adapter (DC 5.0 V, 1.0 A, 5.0 W).

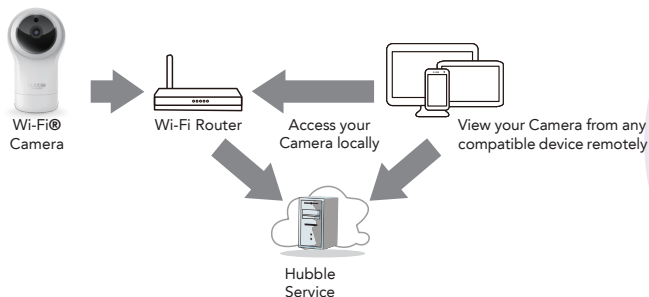

3.2 Getting started - Connecting Devices

How does it work?



When a user tries to access the Camera, our Hubble server authenticates the user's identity and permits access to the Camera.



3.3 Setup

Connect the Wi-Fi® Camera to the Power Adapter, then plug into mains power. The Camera must be within range of the Wi-Fi® router with which you want to connect. Make sure the password of the router is available for entering during the in-app setup process.

LED status indicators

Status		LED Behaviour
1	Power Up Initialising	The BLUE LED lights for around 5 seconds then extinguishes
2	Camera is initialised	The RED LED blinks every second
3	Pair mode (after long press of the pair button approx 5 secs)	The RED and BLUE LEDs blink alternately
4	Camera set-up and connected to server	The BLUE LED is on continuously
5	Connected to router previously but connection to server is lost	The RED LED blinks every 2 seconds

Note: You can only setup via a compatible smartphone or tablet and not via a PC.

3.4 User Account and Camera Setup on Android™ Devices or iPhone®/iPad®

What you need

- Wi-Fi® Camera Unit
- Power adapter for the Camera
- Device with Android™ system version 7.0 and above
- Or iPhone®/iPad® with iOS version 10.0 and above

3.4.1 Power ON and Connect the Camera

- Connect the power adapter to mains power and insert the plug into the power socket on the back of the Camera Unit, the unit turns on.



3.4.2 Download HubbleClub by Hubble Connected App



- Scan the QR code with your smart device and download HubbleClub by Hubble Connected App from the App Store for iOS devices or from the Google Play™ Store for Android™ devices.
- Install HubbleClub by Hubble Connected App on your device.

3.4.3 Sign up with Hubble on your smart device

- Ensure that your smart device is connected to your Wi-Fi® router.
- Run HubbleClub by Hubble Connected App, tap Sign Up with Hubble (fig. 1), read through the Privacy Policy, Terms and Conditions, by signing up you agree to our terms of service before tap Done (fig. 2), enter your account information to sign up with Hubble.

Note:

If you already have a Hubble App account, please tap Log in with Hubble to go to the next steps.

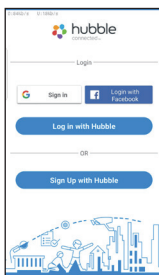

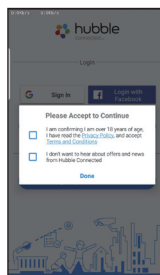

3.4.4 Add the Camera to your account

- Log in your Hubble Account by entering "User Name" and "Password" (fig. 3).
- Tap  on the screen of your device to add new Camera (fig. 4)

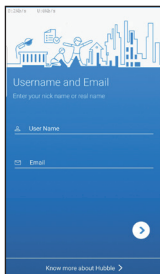

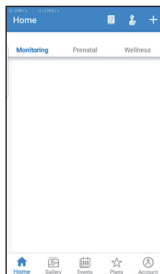

- To select your device for setting up by tapping Baby Monitoring (fig. 5).
- Tap **Nursery Pal Glow** to add the new camera (fig. 6) .

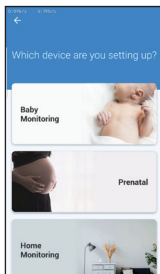

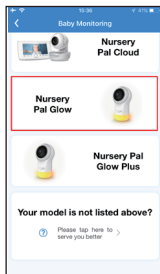

- The following setup instructions will appear on the screen, select your Wi-Fi network and enter "Password" (fig. 7).
- Power on your camera and wait for the Red LED flashing on the camera. (fig. 8)

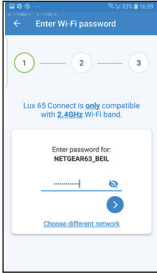

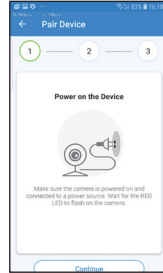

- Press and hold the PAIR button on the bottom of the Camera, you will hear a voice prompt "Ready for Pairing" then tap Continue. (fig. 9)
- Tap Generate QR code on your device and hold the QR code 15 to 30 cm in front of Camera to get scanned till you will hear confirmation message "Scanning Success" from your device. (fig. 9a, fig. 10, fig. 10a)

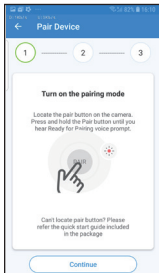

- The Camera has been successfully connected, name your Camera (fig. 12).

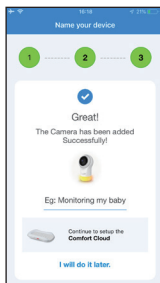

4. Camera Functions













4.1 Connecting the Camera Unit to power

- Connect the power adapter to an electrical outlet and insert the plug into the micro USB socket on the back of the Camera Unit.
- The Blue LED will illuminate after approximately 30 seconds if the camera is set up. The Red LED will flash if the camera is not set up. (Note: To switch off the device, unplug the power supply.)
- Run the Hubble App on your smart device.

4.2 Overview of the Features on Hubble App

	Event History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tap Event History  to access the video record list that is triggered by Motion or Sound detection. • Delete Events  Tap to delete selected event(s).
	Photo/Video	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take a photo or record a video from your Camera. • Tap the Video icon  to activate Video function. Tap and hold the red button  to start recording and release to stop. • Tap the Camera icon  to switch to Camera mode. You can capture photos from Camera view. <p>Note: <i>Photos and videos will be stored in the internal flash memory of your smart device, and can be accessed via the Gallery  or Media Player (Android Device). To play videos, please use the Hubble App.</i></p>

5. Procedure for Resetting the Camera

Note: If your Camera is moved from one router (e.g. home) to another (e.g. office) or you have Camera setup issues, then the Camera must be reset. Please reset the Camera with the following procedures:

- Press and hold the PAIR button approximately 20 seconds, you will hear a long beep then release PAIR button, wait for the Camera Unit to complete an internal reset procedure. The Red LED will begin to flash when the Camera Unit is reset successfully.
- You can add your Camera again by following the steps in section 3.4.4.



6. Disposal of the Device (environment)

At the end of the product life cycle, you should not dispose of this product with normal household waste. Take this product to a collection point for the recycling of electrical and electronic equipment. The symbol on the product, user's guide and/or box indicates this.

7. Cleaning

Noise interference on your device

- To avoid background noise or echoes, ensure that there is enough distance between your device and the Wi-Fi® Camera Unit.
- Use of other 2.4 GHz products, such as Bluetooth™ systems or microwave ovens, may cause interference with this product. Keep the Wi-Fi® Camera Unit at least 1.5 metre away from these types of products, or switch them off if they appear to be causing interference.

Lost connection

- Check your Wi-Fi® settings. If necessary, reconnect your Wi-Fi®. Ensure that the Camera Unit is switched ON. Wait a few minutes to make the connection with the Wi-Fi® system.

If you forgot your password

- If you do not remember your password, tap Forgot Password and submit your e-mail address. A new password will be sent to your e-mail address immediately.
