RE: FCC Part 15 certification for FCC ID:VTZSR15-CBR1-0; request for confidentiality  
by Kenetics Innovations Pte. Ltd.

In accordance with Section 47CFR 0.459, [Kenetics Innovations Pte. Ltd.](#) (henceforth [Kenetics](#)) hereby requests confidentiality of **Block Diagrams, Schematics/Circuit Diagrams, Parts/Material List and Operational Description** attachments for this equipment application.

The request for confidentiality is supported by three reasons:

- This equipment authorization confidentiality request falls squarely under one of the categories for “Records not routinely available for Public inspection” as specified in 47CFR 0.457(d)(ii).
- This is a RFID contactless card scanning device. Records of scanning devices are advisedly excluded from public inspection (as outlined in 47CFR 0.457(d)(ii)), to prevent illegal modification of such devices rendering the device capability to illegally scan information not supposedly intended.
- The design concept and architecture of the product is proprietary and its confidentiality is crucial for the manufacturer to retain a niche edge in this highly competitive RFID reader industry.

Therefore, for all reasons of security, protection of countless contactless card information, and the retention of the manufacturer’s competitive edge, all documents giving aid to modification/copying of transceiver characteristics, viz. **Block Diagrams, Schematics/Circuit Diagrams, Parts/Material List and Operational Description** should be safely kept confidential and vaulted away.
