


# **POS 274 Series**

### **Features**






- 1. Power On/Off
- 2. 2MP Webcam
- 3. Touch screen
- 4. Ambient light sensor

- 7. Battery cover

- 10. Access cover for audio jack and USB port

\*Smart card reader and hand belt are optional items; will be installed to system prior to shipping

## **Getting Started**

### 1. Power-on / Power-off



Push the power button to turn on the system and hold 4 seconds to turn off the system.


**Note**: For best touch performance, remove the protective plastic overlay from the LCD screen by peeling it away from one of the corners. Be sure to use a soft pointing device or finger tip to avoid scratching the screen during normal use.


## 2. Charing the Battery



To charge the battery, pry open the rubber cover protecting the DC-in port and plug in the AC adaptor cable supplied with the tablet.


### 3. Replacing the Battery





A plastic tab is attached to the battery module. For easier removal pull the plastic tab upwards to release the battery from the unit.

## 4. Installing a microSD<sup>™</sup>Card



Power down the system first and then remove the battery module.


Find the microSD<sup>™</sup> card slot located at the bottom right corner of the system.

- Inserting the microSD<sup>™</sup> card: Insert the microSD<sup>™</sup> card into the storage card slot with its gold contacts facing down and push it until it clicks into place.
- Removing the microSD<sup>™</sup> card: Push the card into eject it. Press and hold the card tab, and then slide the card out from the card slot.

### 5. Installing Smart Card Reader




Pry open the battery cover first, and then remove the rubber cover securing the docking board.



Position the smart card reader over the system as shown and fasten with the screws(x4). Finally cover the rubber pads(x4) provided.

### 6. Attaching the Hand Belt



Align and attach the hand belt to the back side of the tablet and fasten the screws (x4) to secure it.

## **LED Indicator**

Power level is indicated by the battery status indicator LED on the front of the tablet.

**GREEN** – Battery fully charged (Tablet is plugged in or placed in dock)

ORANGE – Battery charging (Tablet is plugged in or placed in dock)

RED/Flashing - Battery is low

**RED** – Battery nearly depleted
