USER MANUAL

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read these instructions – All the safety and operating instructions should be read before this product is operated.
2. Keep these instructions. The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
3. Heed all warnings. All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
4. Do not use this apparatus near water. The device should not be used near water or moisture – for example, in a wet basement or near a swimming pool, and the like.
5. Clean only with a dry cloth.
6. Do not block any ventilation openings.
7. Do not operate or place near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.



DEVICE CONTROL FEATURES



1. FM ANTENNA
2. POWER BUTTON. Press to turn power ON/OFF
3. PLAY/PAUSE BUTTON. In media play mode, press to Start or Pause playing.
4. STOP BUTTON. In SD/USB Mode, press to stop playing.
5. FUNCTION BUTTON. Press to select from playing modes: BT, USB, SD, AUX, or Radio. When in Radio, press to toggle between AM & FM.
6. NEXT BUTTON. In media play mode, press to select the next track. Press & hold to fast forward.
7. PREV BUTTON. In media play mode, press to select the previous track. Press & hold to fast reverse.
8. USB SOCKET
9. SD SOCKET
10. AUX IN JACK
11. PHONES JACK
12. TUNING DIAL. Rotate to select radio frequency.
13. VOLUME CONTROL DIAL. Rotate to adjust volume.
14. POWER SOCKET

USING THE DEVICE

Charging the Device

This unit is supplied with a rechargeable battery. The battery duration is 5 hours.

Battery Precautions

- **WARNING:** Do not expose battery to excessive heat, such as strong sunlight or fire.
- **IMPORTANT:** The battery compartment is not accessible by the user. It is reserved for after sales service.
- **IMPORTANT:** Do not charge the battery with the AC/DC adaptor for more than 24 hours.
- If the unit has not been used for a long time, the rechargeable battery may be completely discharged into a “sleep mode” condition. This is a characteristic of all the rechargeable batteries.
- When charging the battery for the first time, charge it for at least 30 minutes, but no longer than 24 hours.
- Use only the supplied rechargeable battery.

Battery Charging

- Connect the unit by USB cord and inserting the DC 5V IN jack, and plug the adaptor (not included) into AC wall outlet.
- While charging, the RADIO indicator light will illuminate and flash. It will turn off when the unit is fully charged.

Turning the Device ON and OFF

- Turn On the device by pressing the Power button.
- Turn Off the device by pressing the Power button.

Playing Music and Adjusting the Volume

- When in a Media Mode, press the Play/Pause Button to Play or Pause tracks from Bluetooth devices, USB Drives, and SD Cards.
- Rotate the Volume Control Dial to adjust the volume.

Selecting Device Modes

Press the Function button to select from Bluetooth, USB/SD, AUX, or RADIO.

Activating & Using Bluetooth Mode

1. Press the Function button until Bluetooth Mode is activated.
2. Using an external Bluetooth device, such as a smartphone, activate the Bluetooth function and connect to 'VICTOR VAS-3002'.
3. Press PLAY button to play or pause playback.
4. Rotate volume control to adjust volume level.
5. Press PREV/NEXT to select tracks.

NOTES:

- The Bluetooth effective receiving distance is approximately 10 meters.
- Other Bluetooth devices might operate differently. Consult device user manuals for specific instructions.

Activating & Using USB/SD Mode

1. Insert the USB or SD Drive.
2. Press PLAY button to play or pause playback.
3. Rotate volume control to adjust volume level.
4. Press PREV/NEXT to select tracks.

Activating Auxiliary Mode

1. Insert a 3.5mm cable to the AUX-in port, and connect the other end of the 3.5mm cable into the auxiliary device.
2. Use the controls of the auxiliary device to play, pause, and select tracks.

Activating & Using Radio Mode

Press the Function button until Radio Mode is selected.

- To toggle between AM or FM, press the Function button.
- To select a station, rotate the TUNING dial.
- To increase the FM signal strength, fully extend the telescopic antenna.
