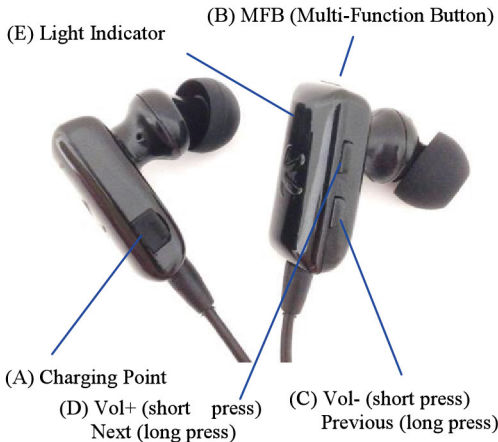

- V4.0. A2DP, AVRCP, HS/HF Profiles.
- PIN code of '0000'.
- Operating distance up to 10 meters (33feet).

Charging the MarathonS

- Red light flashing indicates low battery.
- Plug the USB charging cable into the MarathonS Charger port (A).
- Plug the other side of the USB charging cable into a powered USB port. When charging, the LED (E) will be lit.
- LED (E) will turn off when unit is finished charging. (~2 hours)

Note: Do not try to charge MarathonS if it is wet.

Pairing MarathonS to phone/transmitter

- Turn off all previously paired Bluetooth devices to MarathonS.
- Press MFB button (B) for about 6secs until Red LED (E) flashes.
- Set your phone/transmitter in pairing mode, refer to your device user guide.
- Select "KOKKIA MarathonS" on phone.
- Enter pin code '0000' to pair and connect MarathonS to your phone.
- Blue LED (E) flashes when paired and connected successfully.

Powering ON/OFF

- ON: Press MFB Button (B), until Blue LED lights up. To re-connect to previously paired device, just power ON MarathonS
- OFF: Press MFB Button (B), until Red LED lights up.

MarathonS Functions

- Receive Call: Quick press, release MFB (B)
- Hang-up call: Quick press, release MFB (B)
- Re-dial Last Number: Double quick press, release MFB (B)
- Reject In-coming Call: Press MFB (B) for 1 sec, and release press
- Mute/Un-Mute Microphone during Voice call: Double quick press MFB (B)
- Enter/Exit Voice Control: Quick Press Vol+, Vol-together.
- Multi-point: MarathonS can be paired to 2 cell-phones to receive voice calls from either phone. Turn off Bluetooth of 1st cell-phone when pairing MarathonS to 2nd cell-phone.
- Play/Pause Music: Quick Press Release MFB (B)
- Volume +: Quick Press (D). Volume -: Quick Press (C)
- Next: Long Press (D). Previous: Long Press (C)
