TX91503 – 915 MHz PowerSpot® Transmitter



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The Powercast TX91503 PowerSpot transmitter is specially designed to provide both power and data to end devices containing Powercast's power harvesting technology. The TX91503 contains a receiver that can hear when a harvesting device is in range, allowing the TX91503 to stop power transmission when no harvesting devices are around. The TX91503 can also be controlled by an app that can set periods of use. The TX91503 is housed in a durable plastic case with several mounting options. Operational power is provided to the DC power connector. The TX91503 includes a status LED to provide feedback on functional state. The TX91503 has a factory set, fixed power output of 3W EIRP.

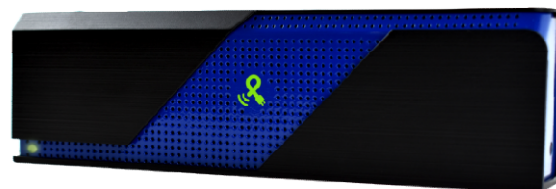

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SET-UP AND OPERATION

1. Mount the TX91503 at the back of a desk or counter to create a PowerSpot® recharging zone. For wall mounted applications, use the keyholes on the back of the unit to hang the TX91503 for recharging devices like closet hung wearables.
2. Plug the DC connector of the power supply into the connector on the TX91503. Plug the power supply into a 120V outlet.
3. The TX91503 will remain off until one of the following occurs¹:
 - a. An authorized device enters the PowerSpot recharging zone.
 - b. The button on the unit is pressed to recharge a device with a completely discharged battery. The unit will activate for 30 minutes from a button press and then will turn off if an authorized device is not present.
4. When the TX91503 is active and transmitting radio frequency (RF) energy, data is automatically included in the transmission and can be received and used to authorize the device.

The status LED indicates the following operating conditions:

LED	Status	Description
Off	Off	5VDC is not applied
Solid Green	Active	Transmitting normally
Solid Red	Idle	TX91503 is powered but not actively transmitting
Red with short Green Blinks	Active / Idle	An authorized device is requesting charge but is not in range of the TX91503
Red and Green Rapid Blinking	Fault	TX91503 is in a fault condition such as overheating

Note: When setting the time or schedule on the TX91503 via the mobile application, immediately after sending the command from the mobile phone the TX91503 will blink the LED to acknowledge that the time or schedule was received and set successfully.

FIRMWARE UPDATES

If a firmware upgrade is available for the TX91503:

1. Unplug the power
2. Press and hold the button down
3. With the button still pressed, plug the unit back in. Once powered on, the LED will shine green steadily
4. Within 2 minutes, utilize the recommended mobile phone application to connect to the TX91503 and upload the firmware upgrade. Once the upgrade is complete, unplug the power and plug it back in.

Note: If the TX91503 is not connected to the mobile phone application within 2 minutes, the TX91503 will automatically return to normal operation.

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Note: The TX91503 will not transmit the RF energy that is used for power and data as described above during a firmware upgrade.

To determine the current firmware version of the TX91503:

1. Press and hold the button on the TX91503 for at least 5 seconds
2. Continue holding the button and utilize the recommended mobile phone application to determine the firmware version.

The TX91503 will stop communicating the firmware version and return to normal operation when the button is released.

Note: The TX91503 will not transmit the RF energy that is used for power and data as described above while communicating the firmware version.

¹The app can override these conditions and keep the transmitter in an OFF state.

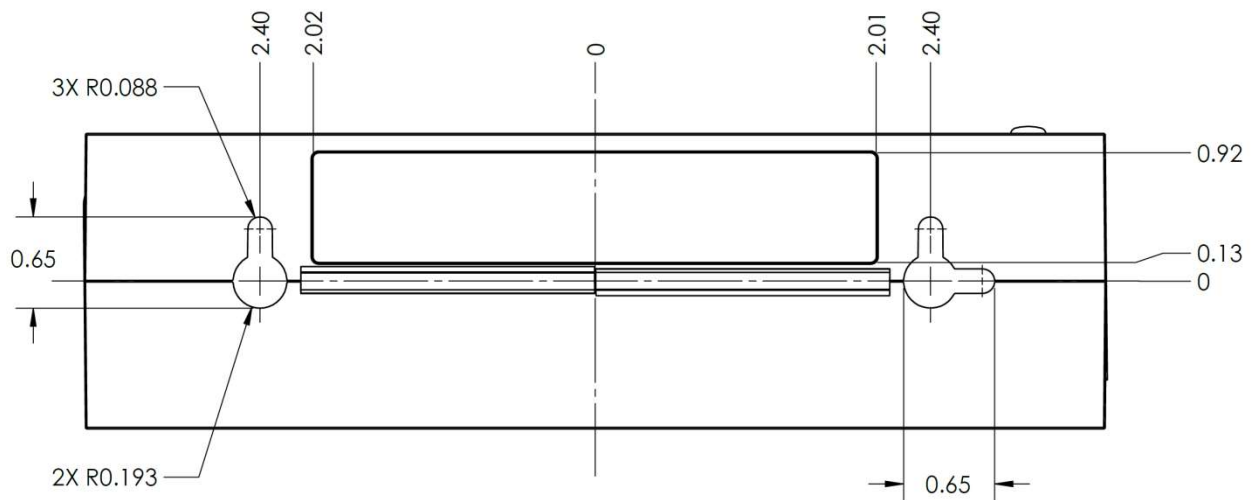
