

MAKING PHONE CALLS

ACCOUNT

The GVC3200 supports up to 9-way video conference, please register the account to the server before making calls. The following figure shows the accounts are successfully registered (account icon is green). This displays on the left side of the top status bar in your LCD display device.

DIAL SCREEN

Once the account is successfully registered, users could use one of the following 3 ways to bring up dial screen to start making calls.

- Press the DIAL icon  in the lower right corner of the remote control.
- On the LCD display device, click on icon  on home screen.
- On the LCD display device, click on Applications and select  to bring up dial screen.

Enter digits in the dial-up box, if the digits or the letters for the digit matches contacts and call history, a dropdown list of numbers will be displayed. For example, entering 5 (JKL), 6 (MNO), 4 (GHI) and 6 (MNO) will display 5646 or john if contact "john" exists. The matching characters will be highlighted in red.




Figure 20 GVC3200 Call Screen

- Press the red shortcut key on the remote control to bring up call mode setting screen, set call mode to Call, Paging or IP call;
- Press the yellow shortcut key to set call type to Audio or Video;
- Press the blue shortcut key to switch to BlueJeans or SIP Call.
- Click on "Cancel" icon on screen or press  key on the remote control to cancel the call.

DIALING A NUMBER DIRECTLY

1. Open the dial screen.
2. Use the remote control keyboard to enter digits, or click the input box to enter using the pop-out soft keyboard;
3. Press  on the remote control to dial out, or move the cursor to the icon  on dial screen and click it to dial out.



Note:

1. By default, the GVC3200 allows users to press # key as SEND key. This behavior can be disabled via option "Use # as Dial Key" under web GUI.
2. When entering initials or full spellings of a name that exists in the contact, this contact will show in the dropdown list. For example, if the user inputs Amy by pressing the corresponding digits "2" (ABC), "6" (MNO), "9" (WXYZ) on the remote control, Amy's name and number will be displayed in the list if it exists in the contact. Users can then select it to dial out.

REDIAL

Users can dial out the last dialed number if there is dialed call log. Access the dial screen and then press "#" key or  on the remote control to dial out.

DIALING A NUMBER VIA CONTACT

Follow the steps below to dial a number via Contacts.



1. On the LCD display device, access Contacts by tapping on  on home screen;
2. Navigate and select in the contacts entries using the remote control navigation keys;
3. Press  on the remote control to dial out.

DIALING A NUMBER VIA CALL HISTORY

1. On the LCD display device, access Applications on home screen and access call history by selecting  icon;
2. The LCD will display all call history types. Navigate in the call history list by selecting the call history category. Select the call history entry you would like to dial out;
3. Press  on the remote control to dial out.

DIRECT IP CALL

Direct IP Call allows GVC3200 and another VoIP device to talk to each other in an ad-hoc fashion without a SIP proxy. VoIP calls can be made between these two if:

- Both GVC3200 and VoIP phone have public IP addresses
Or
- Both GVC3200 and VoIP phone are on the same LAN/VPN using private or public IP addresses
Or
- Both devices can be connected through a router using public or private IP addresses (with necessary port forwarding or DMZ).

To make a direct IP call, please follow the steps below:

1. Access the dial screen on GVC3200;
2. Press the red shortcut key on the remote control to bring up call mode setting screen, set the mode to "IP Call";
3. Input the target IP address. For example, if the target IP address is 192.168.124.123 and the port is 5062, input the following:
192*168*124*123#5062
The * key represents the dot (.) and the # key represents the colon (:).
4. Press the yellow shortcut key on the remote control to select "Audio Call" or "Video Call";
5. Press  on the remote control to dial out.

PAGING/INTERCOM

Before placing paging/intercom, please make sure the callee has paging/intercom enabled so it can automatically answer the paging/intercom call. To make paging/intercom call:

1. Access the dial screen on GVC3200;
2. Press the red shortcut key on the remote control to bring up call mode setting screen, set the mode to "Paging/Intercom";
3. Enter the number to dial;
4. Press the yellow shortcut key on the remote control to select "Audio Call" or "Video Call";

5. Press  on the remote control to dial out.

ANSWERING A CALL

SINGLE INCOMING CALL

When the device is in idle and there is an incoming video call, the device will show the call screen as below. Select "Video Answer" to answer the call with both video and audio, "Audio Answer" to answer the call with audio only, or "End" to reject the call using the remote control navigation keys.

MULTIPLE CALLS/CALL WAITING

When there is an incoming call during an active call, users will hear a call waiting tone with the LCD displaying the caller name and ID for the incoming call.




Figure 21 GVC3200 Multiple Incoming Calls

Similar to single incoming call, users could select "Audio" to answer with audio only, "Video" to answer with video and audio, or "End" to reject the call using remote control navigation keys.



Note:

By default, answering a call during an active call will automatically add this party into the conference. To answer the call separately without establishing the conference, users could log in web UI->Settings->Call Settings to select "Disable Conference".

SWITCHING LINES DURING CALL

When there are multiple calls on the GVC3200, there could be only one line in talking status while the others will be put on hold. The users can use the Left/Right buttons on the remote control to switch between the call. Unhold the call after selecting the line and then the users can talk using this line.



Note:

By default, answering a call during an active call will automatically add this party into the conference. To answer the call separately without establishing the conference, users need to log in web UI->Settings->Call Settings to select "Disable Conference".

CALL HOLD

During an active call, press HOLD button  to put the call on hold, then you can dial out the second call.

- On the LCD display, click on  to resume the call
- On the LCD display, click on  or press  on the remote control to end the call.

If the current call is a video call, the screen will not display remote video when being put on hold.

CALL TRANSFER

A call can be transferred to another party during the call. The GVC3200 supports blind transfer and attended transfer. To use transfer, users need to log in web UI->Settings->Call Settings and select "Disable Conference" first.

BLIND TRANSFER

1. During an active call, click on TRANSFER button  on the call screen to bring up the transfer interface;
2. Select transfer mode as "Blind" by pressing the blue shortcut key on the remote control. The default transfer mode is "Blind";
3. Enter the digits to dial out. If wrong digit is entered, press  key on the remote control to delete it;
4. Press  on the remote control or click on  on the screen;
5. The call will be transferred and the GVC3200 will hang up the call.

AUTO-ATTENDED TRANSFER

The GVC3200 supports auto attended transfer which provides users a fast and easy way to complete attended transfer.

1. During an active call, click on TRANSFER icon  on the call screen to bring up the transfer screen;
2. Press the blue shortcut key on the remote control to select transfer mode as "Attended";
3. Enter the digits to dial out. If wrong digit is entered, press  key on the remote control to delete it;
4. Press  on the remote control or click on  on the screen.
5. When the GVC3200 hears the ringback tone,

- If the user hangs up the call, the call will be transferred before answer.
- If the user clicks "Cancel", the transfer will be cancelled.
- If the call is answered, the second call will be established on the GVC3200. The user could then hang up the call or press the "Transfer" soft key to complete the transfer.
- If the user clicks on "Split" to separate the calls, the GVC3200 will establish call with the second call while placing the first call on hold.

ATTENDED TRANSFER

Besides auto-attended transfer, users could also consult the third party first before transferring the call.

1. During the active call, press  on the remote control to bring up the transfer screen, or click on  MORE icon on the call screen and then select "add call". This will place the current call on hold;
2. The second call establishes after the call is answered;
3. Click on TRANSFER button  to bring up transfer screen. The first call on hold will be displayed;
4. Press the blue shortcut key on the remote control to select transfer mode as "Attended" in the transfer screen to transfer the call;
5. The call will be transferred and the GVC3200 will hang up the call.

MUTE

During an active call, press the MUTE button  to mute the call, press the button again to unmute the call.

You can also tap on icon  on the call screen to mute/unmute the call.

CALL RECORDING

During the call, users could record the video to the external SD card plugged into the GVC3200. Once recorded, the users can view the recorded video in Recorder application and download the video from web UI->Maintenance->Recording. For more details, please refer to the chapter **RECORDER**.

1. During an active call, press the recording key  on the remote control. A red Rec icon will show on the upper left of the screen;
2. The recording files will be automatically saved to the external SD card when the call is finished.

Users could also press  on the remote control to stop recording anytime;

DND (DO NOT DISTURB)

When DND is on, the incoming calls to the GVC3200 will be blocked without ringing. The DND

 icon will be displayed in the status bar on the top of the screen when DND is turned on.

- When the GVC3200 is in idle screen, the user can press  button on the remote control to turn on/off DND.
- When the GVC3200 is in an active call, the user could turn on/off DND in call screen->MORE options. This will not affect the current call and it will take effect starting from the next incoming call.

MISSED CALL



When there is a missed call, the call icon  on home screen will show the number of missed calls. Once accessed the dial screen, the reminder icon will disappear.

CALL FORWARD

Call forward (Unconditional/No-answer/Busy/Time-based) can be set up from web GUI. Log in GVC3200 web GUI and go to Settings page->Account->Call Settings. For details, please refer to "GVC3200 Administration Guide".

CONFERENCE

LAYOUT

The GVC3200 supports up to 9-way conference. The GVC3200 can be the host to initiate a conference or join other conferences as a member.

You can connect multiple HDMI output devices for conference. HDMI 1 interface is the primary output when plugging in multiple HDMI display devices. The device connected to HDMI 1 interface will display local site by default while other devices automatically display remote sites. If the VGA/HDMI IN device is plugged in to the GVC3200, the device connected to HDMI 1 interface displays presentation of VGA/HDMI input while other devices will display video view.

During the conference, you can also tap on  to go back to HOME screen, with the conference video displayed in the background.

INITIATING CONFERENCE

The conference can be initiated in multiple ways.

From Call Screen:

- Access the call screen, enter the number in the text box or select members from the list below;
- Press  on the remote control or click on  on the screen to dial out.

From Schedule

For more details, please refer to chapter **SCHEDULE**.

ANSWERING AN INCOMING CALL IN CONFERENCE

You can specify how your GVC3200 handles incoming calls. Depending on your configuration, your GVC3200 automatically answers a call or prompts you to answer a call manually:

- Log in GVC3200 web GUI and go to Settings page->Account->Call Settings and set "Auto-answer" option to "Yes". All incoming calls will be automatically answered. If it's a video call, it will be answered with video as well.
- If "Auto Answer" is set to No, the user will need manually select to answer with video, audio or reject the call using the remote control on the LCD prompt.

CONFERENCE MANAGEMENT

The following figure shows a 3-way conference established.



Figure 22 GVC3200 3-Way Conference



Redial: Dial out the number again if the previous dialing failed.



Add member: Access dial screen and add more numbers to join conference.



Delete member: Select member to delete.



Conference control. Control conference members. Including mute , disable sound , camera control  and pause video .



Suspend: Pause/resume conference. Once paused, the GVC3200 will stop sending local video to the remote party.



Presentation: Turn on/off presentation. HDMI IN or VGA IN must be plugged in first.



More: Bring up more options including mixing video with Third party applications (only available when the application is installed on GVC3200), view call details, set DND, open DTMF and switch mainstream and sub stream.



End: End conference and go back to home screen.

Users could press the red/blue/yellow shortcut keys on the remote control to input DTMF, view notifications and view status.

During the active conference call, if there is a new member joining conference, an outgoing call failed or a member hanging up, there will be a prompt box on the left side of the conference screen showing notifications. The notification prompt will be automatically hidden if there is no new notification in 2 seconds.

On the right side of the video conference screen, users can see member status such as audio/video calls, or whether the call is being muted.

If the current participants also use the GVC3200, you can press the camera control key  on the remote control to control PTZ device of the opposite side.

Table 15 GVC3200 Conference Member Status Descriptions

Icons	Descriptions
	The current line is in an audio call.
	The current line is in a video call.
	The current line is being muted.
	The current line is not connected.

The operations toolbar on the bottom of the video conference screen will be automatically hidden if there is no operation in 5 seconds. Press any key to bring up the toolbar again.

INVITE MEMBERS TO CONFERENCE

Users could use one of the following ways to add members.

- Access the dial screen by clicking on the ADD icon  on conference screen. Then enter the number to dial out. Once the member answers the call, it will be connected into the conference automatically.
- When GVC3200 is on conference screen, press  on the remote control to access the call screen. Then enter the number to dial out. Once the member answers the call, it will be connected into the conference automatically.

The member calls the conference number. If the host answers the call, the member will join conference automatically.

REMOVING MEMBER FROM CONFERENCE

To remove a member from the conference, click on the DELETE icon  on conference screen. Then select the member from the member list and press the "OK" key to delete it.

CONFERENCE CONTROL

 Tap on  to make operations like mute, disable sound, camera control and suspend video. The conference control screen is as shown below.




Figure 23 Conference Control Screen

1. Use Up/Down navigation keys on the remote control to select conference member;
2. Use Left/Right navigation keys on the remote control to make operations and press the "OK" key to set, press the "OK" key again to cancel. E.g. Tap on  to mute one member and the icon will turn to  , tap on again to restore.



Note:

User could also use the icon  on the remote control during the conference to mute/unmute the local party.

Users could press the shortcut keys on the remote control on conference control screen to mute all, block all or suspend videos.

PAUSE CONFERENCE

The video will be stopped if the conference is paused. You will not see the video view of the members and the other members won't see you either.



Note:

1. The new incoming call will be rejected if the conference is paused.
2. The presentation will be displayed normally when the conference is paused.

PRESENTATION SHARING

The GVC3200 supports dual stream video, with the presentation sharing function, you can connect VGA/HDMI input devices such as a computer or DVD player to your GVC3200 and share the VGA/HDMI input source content with remote parties while they can still view the video of local GVC3200.

If the members cannot receive dual stream, you can switch the stream to mainstream so that the members can still view the presentation. To switch stream,



1. On the conference screen, select MORE button ->"Switch to substream";
2. Press the "OK" key on the remote control and the presentation will be sent to remote parties as substream.

The following figure shows 3 TVs used for GVC3200. The one on the top shows presentation, the two on the bottom show remote party video.

Note:

When both HDMI IN interface and VGA IN interface are connected, the GVC3200 will only display the device connected to HDMI IN port.

CONFERENCE RECORDING

During the video conference, press $*/\circ$ on the remote control to record conference, press the key again to stop recording. The recording will be automatically saved to the external SD card plugged into the GVC3200.



Note:

GVC3200 only support save the recording file to the external SD card, if not detected external SD card or the SD card is full when pressing the recording key $*/\circ$, the recording will be failed.

CALL DETAILS

Users could view audio and video details of the conference members. On the conference screen, click on



and select “Call Details”.

TURNING ON DND IN CONFERENCE

When DND is enabled during conference, the new incoming calls will be blocked. On the conference

screen, use the remote control to click on MORE button  and select "DND";

The icon  will be displayed on conference which has set DND mode. To disabled DND, Select DND mode again and press the "OK" key to cancel.



Note:

When set DND mode during a conference, the DND mode still effective when the conference is over. to

To disable DND, please press  on the remote control when there is no active call.

CONFERENCE LOCK

Users could lock/unlock the scheduled conference. Once locked, the other incoming calls will unable to join conference.



The locked scheduled conference will display  on below screen.

OPEN DTMF

The user can dial DTMF during the conference.

1. On the remote control, press the red shortcut key, or click on MORE button  -> select "Open DTMF" on the conference screen to bring up the DTMF input screen;
2. Press the digital keys on the remote control to input DTMF. Press  to cancel if needed.

THIRD PARTY APPLICATIONS

The GVC3200 runs the Android Operating System and therefore offers full access to the hundreds of thousands of Android apps in the Google Play Store, including Microsoft Lync™, Skype™, Google Hangout™ and etc. The calls using certain apps can be mixed with the SIP call so that they can be brought into the same conference on the GVC3200.

For example, to use third party app Microsoft Lync™ during the conference:

1. Install Microsoft Lync™ and sign in;
2. Establish a conference call on the GVC3200;
3. On the conference screen, click on MORE button  and select "Third party applications";
4. Press the "OK" key, and select Lync application in the popup menu;
5. Search contacts in Lync and dial out;
6. The new call will be added to conference.

END CONFERENCE

To end the conference, tap on END button  or press key  on the remote control to disconnect. If the GVC3200 is the conference host, ending the conference will disconnect all the members from the conference. If the conference member hangs up the call, it will be disconnected from the conference but other parties in the conference will stay in the conference.

SCHEDULE

SCHEDULE feature allows the user to set a specific time to hold a conference in advance, with conference reminder and members.




Figure 26 GVC3200 Schedule Screen

Follow one of the ways below to access schedule conference screen:

- On the home screen, click on CONFERENCE button .
- On the home screen, click on APPLICATION button  and select .
- Users will see the scheduled conferences (after the current time) in the schedule screen. Select one conference entry to view details.



Note:

Conferences that have been held in the past will not be displayed in the schedule screen.

VIEW CONFERENCE DETAILS

Users could view scheduled conference details after the current time. Select one conference and press the "OK" key on the remote control to view conference details.




Figure 27 Conference Details Screen

ADD SCHEDULED CONFERENCE

Follow the steps below to add a scheduled conference:

1. On the home screen, select  to access schedule screen;
2. On the remote control, press the yellow shortcut to “Add Conference” screen as below;




Figure 28 GVC3200 Add Conference Screen

3. Fill in conference name, members, start time, conference duration, etc.;

4. Press the yellow shortcut key on the remote control to save the scheduled conference.

Table 16 Add Conference Parameters

Parameters	Descriptions
Title	Set the conference name to identify this conference.
Members	Click on button  to access the Add Member screen. You can add one member or a group of members. Press the yellow key on the remote control to save and go back to schedule screen. Up to 8 members can be added.
Start Time	Configure when the conference starts.
Duration (Min)	Configure conference duration.
Reminder Time	Configure whether to remind users in advance. A prompt dialog box will pop up on the GVC3200 screen 10 minutes before the conference starts.
Auto Answer For Conference Member	Configure whether to answer the call from the conference member automatically. If the call is not from the conference member, it will not be answered automatically.
Lock	Users could lock/unlock the scheduled conference. Once locked, the other incoming calls will be unable to join conference.

EDIT SCHEDULED CONFERENCE

Follow the steps below to edit scheduled conference:

1. Access conference schedule screen and select the conference entry you would like to edit;
2. Press the blue shortcut key on the remote control to access edit screen;
3. Press the yellow shortcut key on the remote control to save changes and go back to schedule screen.

RESCHEDULE CONFERENCE

1. Access schedule screen and select the conference entry you would like to edit;
2. Press the MENU key  on the remote control and select "Reschedule" option;
3. Set new conference start time in the popup dialog box;
4. Click on the SAVE button to save changes. If you would like to cancel the change, or press  on the remote control or click on CANCEL button on the screen.

DELETE SCHEDULED CONFERENCE

Follow the steps below to delete the existing scheduled conference:

1. Access schedule screen and select the conference entry you would like to delete;
2. Press the MENU key  on the remote control and select "Delete".

VOICEMAIL

When there is a new voicemail, voice mail icon  will show up as a notification in the status bar. Users could login the web UI->Settings->Account->General Settings to configure the access number for the voicemail.

Follow the steps below to access voicemail:

1. Access the dial screen and input voicemail access number;
2. Press  on the remote control or click on  on the call screen to dial into the voicemail box;
3. Follow the Interactive Voice Response (IVR) for the message retrieval process.

Users could also go to Home screen->Applications and click on “Voice Mail” to access the voicemail box. The number of new voicemail messages will be shown on the voice mail app icon as well. See figure below.




Figure 29 GVC3200 Voice Mail Application

OTHER FUNCTIONS

REMOTE CONTROL APPLICATION

Besides using the Bluetooth remote control in the GVC3200 package, the users could also download the Grandstream remote control application and install it on an Android device. The remote control application is used via Bluetooth protocol. Follow the steps below to install the remote control application:

1. Download the Grandstream remote control application (GS_RCU.app) for GVC3200 from GS Market and install it on your Android device;
2. Open GS_RCU.app on the Android device and access settings screen;
3. Select the GVC3200 device you would like to connect to. Each discovered GVC3200 could be distinguished by the last 6 digits of its MAC address;
4. Pair GS_RCU.app with the GVC3200 via Bluetooth. Users might see prompt on the GVC3200 and Android device to confirm the passcode during pairing and connection process;
5. After pairing and connecting the remote control application, users can use the keys and options on the Android device touch screen to control the GVC3200.




Figure 30 GVC3200 Remote Control Application on Android Device

- Tap on  in the upper right corner to access settings screen as the left figure shows above.
- Tap on  to go back to home screen as the figure in the middle shows above.
- Tap on  to bring up navigation panel and numeric keyboard as the right figure shows above, tap

on  again to hide the keyboard.

BLUEJEANS

The GVC3200 has built-in BlueJeans access for users to dial BlueJeans calls. Follow the steps below:

1. On the LCD dial screen, press the blue shortcut key on the remote control to switch call mode from SIP Call to BlueJeans.
2. When the call mode shows BlueJeans, input BlueJeans conference ID and conference password.
3. Press  on the remote control or click on  on the screen to dial out.

APPLICATIONS

GVC3200 provides built-in applications such as like Contacts, Call History, FileManager, Browser and etc. Users could also download the apps from GS market or Google Play to install on the GVC3200.

CONTACTS

GVC3200 Contacts app helps users to easily store and manage phone number and contact information. Users can add contacts on the GVC3200 or import contacts from external devices as well as download from a server.

On the GVC3200 home screen, click on CONTACTS icon  , or go to APPLICATIONS and select  to access contacts app.




Figure 31 GVC3200 Contacts Screen

- **All**
Display all contacts.
- **Groups**
View groups. Select one group to view group details.
- **Call**

Select the contact, and press  on the remote control or click on  to dial the contact you would like to call.

- **Delete**
Press the red shortcut key on the remote control to delete contacts.
- **Edit**

Press the yellow shortcut key on the remote control to edit contacts.

- **Add**
Press the blue shortcut key on the remote control to access New Contact screen, fill in contact information and press the yellow shortcut key on the remote control to save it.
- **Menu**
Press  on the remote control to access menu to edit/add/delete/export/import/download contacts.
- **Contact Details**
Select one contact and press the "OK" key on the remote control to view contact details.

ADD CONTACT

ADD SINGLE CONTACT

Follow the steps below to add one single contact.

1. Press the blue shortcut key on the remote control to access New Contact screen.




Figure 32 GVC3200 Add New Contact Screen

2. Enter contact information.
3. Press the red shortcut key to add more fields.
4. Press the yellow shortcut key to save the contact information.

Users could press the red shortcut key to add more contact information.

BATCH IMPORT CONTACTS

Import function allows users to batch import contacts. The phonebook with compatible format needs to be saved to the storage devices like SD card/USB flash drive and plugged into the GVC3200.

1. Press the red shortcut key on the remote control to bring up the Import Contacts screen;




Figure 33 GVC3200 Import Contacts Screen

2. Set the configuration parameters and select the path to save the imported file;
3. Press the yellow shortcut key to save the contact information.

Table 17 GVC3200 Import Contacts Parameters

Parameters	Descriptions
Clear The Old List	If enabled, the previous contact records will be deleted when a new phonebook file is loaded into the phone. If disabled, both the old contacts and new contacts will be kept in the GVC3200.
Replace Duplicate Entries	If enabled, when the phonebook file is imported to the phone, the duplicated entries will be removed. If disabled, both the old contacts and new contacts will be kept in the GVC3200.
File Encoding	Select the encoding format for XML contact file.
File Type	Select the file format for phonebook file import. The device supports xml, csv and vcard format.
Select The File	Select file from storage device plugged into the GVC3200.

DOWNLOAD CONTACT

GVC3200 supports downloading phonebook from the file server to batch add contacts. The default file name the GVC3200 looks for is "phonebook.xml". The phonebook XML file should be placed under the file server directory for the GVC3200 to retrieve.

1. On the contact screen, click on the menu button on the upper right and select "Download" to bring up the Download Contacts screen;




Figure 34 GVC3200 Download Contacts Screen

2. Set the configuration parameters and select the path to save the file;
3. Press the red shortcut key to download.




Figure 35 GVC3200 Export Contacts Screen




Figure 36 Groups Screen




Figure 37 GVC3200 Add Group Screen




Figure 39 GVC3200 Add Contact Screen




Figure 40 Video Screen




Figure 41 Backup Screen




Figure 42 Auto Backup Screen




Figure 43 Restore Backup Screen




Figure 44 GVC3200 Diagnosis Screen




Figure 45 GVC3200 GS Market




Figure 48 GVC3200 Web UI - Call




Figure 49 GVC3200 Web UI - Conference Control




Figure 50 GVC3200 Web UI - Contacts




Figure 51 GVC3200 Web UI - Groups





Figure 52 GVC3200 Web Page—Schedule




Figure 54 GVC3200 Web UI - Video Control
