### 1 Getting started

Remove the device from the box.

Remove packaging from the product.

Place the packaging inside the box and either store or dispose off safely.

### 3 Safety Instruction

- Keep the player clean and never store it next to a heat source or in dirt, humid or wet places. Keep it out of direct sunlight.
- Do not put the player in high temperature places (over 104°F),especially not in a car with the windows closed in summer.
- Press the player's buttons gently. Pressing them or the screen too hard can damage the player.



# 5 Keys definitions



- 1. Power Button: press and hold to power on/off, press to change to sleep mode to save power.
- 2. Vol+/-: increase /decrease the volume.
- 3. Back Button: return to previous menu.
- 4. Home Button: shortcut key to return to the home page during any interface, press and hold to view recent programs.
- 5. Menu Button: popup submenus.
- 6. Headphone jack: connect to headphones.
- 7. TF Card slot: supports up to 32GB (Micro SD card)
- 8. HDMI slot: connect to HDMI cable to play video on television
- 9. Reset button: to restart the device.
- 10. OTG slot: connect to computer via USB, using the supplied USB Cable, you can also use this port to connect the unit to a penpheral device.
- 11. DC jack: connect to power supply (power supply included) to charge.
- 12. Speaker: audio output

# 6 Key Features

#### **Power Button**

- Press power button to switch on unit.
- When the product is switched on, press power button once for "sleep" mode.
- In "sleep" mode press power button once to end sleep mode

#### **Menu Button**

• Press this key to open the menu of the current applications.

#### **Back Button**

 Press this key to return to the previous screen, or the previous menu page.

#### **Home Button**

- Press this key to return to the home screen.
- A long press on this button will open the recently performed applications menu bar.

#### Shutdown

- A long press on the power button, will bring up the shutdown menu.
- Click "OK" to shut down.

## **Unlocking and Locking the Screen**

- After a period of inactivity the screen will automatically move to "Sleep" mode to prolong battery life
- Press and push the icon up to the new emerging green point to unlock.



# **Using the Touch Screen**

There are several ways to browse the home screen, menu and applications on your device.

## Tap

When you want to open an application just tap the icon with your finger.

#### Press and hold

On the home screen, long pressing a blank area of the screen will create a pop up menu where you will be able to select applications to add to home screen. When you press a file, a song, a photo, it will turn up more functions to make next operation.

### Drag

Select the item you wish to move and keep your finger pressed on the application, drag it to the selected area. When in the desired location release move your finger away from the screen to "drop" the application

#### **HDMI Slot**

Connect one end of HDMI cable (not provided in our kit) to this slot and other end to HDMI input of your TV. This enables to play video from device to television.

#### **Home Screen**

The Main Menu screen will display the device's main applications. You can customize your Home Screen by altering Wallpapers and adding / deleting applications and icons.



If you add more applications, icons or shortcuts onto the home screen, you can expand the home screen beyond that which is displayed. Scroll either side of the touch screen to navigate between all your applications and icons.



#### **Customise Home Screen**

# **New Home Project**

- In the home interface, click "menu" button.
- When the pop up menu appears, click "Add" to select the item to add to the home interface.
- When you click "Search", you can use this function to search any file in your device or a webpage.

Tip: To add an application to home screen, long press it until it becomes enlarged and it will drop onto home screen.

# **Removing Icon from Home Screen**

- Tap and hold the icon on the screen until it blinks.
- Hold continuously and drag the icon into the trash bin and then release your fingers.

## Change the desktop wallpaper

- In the home interface, press and hold the Menu button for pop-up menu, tap wallpaper.
- Click to select wallpaper gallery pictures.

#### **Enter text**

# Use the screen keyboard

When you start the program or choose to enter text or numbers, click the text editing box and it will appear on-screen keyboard.

## **Input Method**



- In the text input interface, press and hold the text edit box area, until the pop-up menu appears and select input method.
- Select the input required.

# 7 Access Application

# How to access the device applications:

Press to enter Applications list as shown below.



- Choose the application to access.
- To exit the program interface, press the "back" key to previous page interface or press the "home" key to go directly back to the home page screen

## Tips

## **Open Recently Used Applications**

In any program interface you can long press the "Home" key, the screen a pop up window will appear, which lists the most recently used applications.

# Add Gadgets desktop

On the home screen, long pressing a blank area, of the screen will create a pop up menu where you will be able to select applications to add to home screen


#### **Fast Close Process**

Press the back key to return to previous screen, or press the Home key to return to home page interface.

# 8 Charging your device

We recommend that your first three charges take up to 12 hours each, this will extend the battery life as well as provide a longer usage time. Subsequent charges will only need about 4-6 hours.

#### 9 Connect to PC



Power on the device, then connect to PC via USB cable, pull down the notice bar on the left top of the status bar.

Click "USB connected (Internal)", then select "Mount" to connect and then can copy files to the device.


Pull down the notice bar again you can turn off connection.

# 10 Connecting to the Internet

## Wi-Fi Settings

- Click the application label to pop-up the application list, Click "Settings".
- Click "Wireless & networks"
- Click "Turn on Wi-Fi", the device will automatically scan for available Wi-Fi wireless network.
- Click "Wi-Fi Settings"

- Select the desired Wi-Fi network to connect. For encryption, a password window will pop up, enter the appropriate password.
- Click "connect".



## **E-mail Settings**

Note: Please make sure your network connection is active and the time is correct before you start the Mailbox Setup Wizard.



# **Mailbox Setup wizard**

- Click the application label to pop-up the application list.
- Click the email icon, E-mail setup wizard appears to guide you through set up

- Enter your e-mail account e-mail address and password.
- Click "Next" button, select your mailbox type is POP3 or IMAP.
- Click the "Next" button to check e-mail account server is available.
- Enter account name and e-mail to display the name, then click done.
- If the mailbox is available, will automatically into your inbox

#### Send E-mail information

- Click on the application label and a list of application will pop up.
- Click the e-mail to display your Inbox.
- Click to enter the Inbox, the message will automatically refresh, click to read.
- Press the Menu button on the pop-up menu.
- Click "write", compose a new message into the interface.
- Input the recipient's email address in the receiver column
- Enter a subject and message content.
- Want to add attachments? Press the Menu button on the pop-up menu option.
- Click attachments.
- Select the attachments you want to send (such as pictures, video, etc.).
- Click Send to send the e-mail.


Note: If you have more than one account select the desired account prior to composing e-mails.

#### 12 Music

Your music can be viewed in 4 ways: Artist, Albums, Songs and Playlists. Select a category to view the list of contents.



## Access and play music

- Select a song to play

## Adding songs to a new playlist

- Click on the application label on the pop-up list of applications.
- · Click "Music".
- Search music by track
- Hold the track you want to add to the want to add to the playlist
- On the pop music settings menu, click "Add" to playlist.
- Select "New".
- Enter the name of the playlist.
- Click "Save".

# **Delete Playlist**

- Click "Playlist"
- Press and hold the playlist, this will bring a pop-up menu.
- Click "Delete".

#### 13 Video

# Access and play video files

• Click on the application label on the pop-up list of applications.

- Click "Video Player".
- Enter the memory card video file list.
- Select and click the file you want to play.

# 14 Photo Gallery

The gallery application will automatically search for the micro SD card to store photos and video files. Photo Gallery has folders to categorize the images and video files. You can use the gallery application to view and edit photos, add photos to the desktop or watch videos.


## **View Image**

- Click the picture you want to see, the system automatically opens it in full screen mode view.
- Slide your finger on the screen to view the next or previous images

# **Home Page**

When browser is selected your selected home page will automatically load.

# **Changing your Home Page**

- Click on the application label on the pop-up list of applications.
- Click the browser.
- Press the "menu" key, pop-up browser settings menu.
- Click "more".
- Click "Settings".
- Click "Set Home Page".
- Enter the URL, click "OK"

#### Visit the website

Open the Web page and slide your finger on the screen to browse and see other parts of the page.

# Search word in a Webpage

- Browse the web; press the "menu" button, pop-up menu option.
- Click "more".
- Click "Find on page".
- Enter the words your want to search.
- Click "done" and the words in the webpage will be highlighted in green.
- Click left and right arrows in front of search Bar to move into the previous or next word in line.

## Manage bookmarks

### **Bookmark Settings**

- Launch / Access a website.
- Press the menu key and click "Bookmarks", then click "Add".
- Edit Bookmarks and click "OK".

### **Open Bookmarks**

- In the browser interface, press the Menu key and click the "bookmarks".
- Click on the bookmark you want to open.

#### **Use the Browser Window**

## Open a new browser window

- Open a browser window, press the Menu key and select new window.

# 16 Other Applications

#### **Alarm Clock**

- Click on the application label, pop-up list of applications
- Click the clock program.

- To set the alarm, press the menu button for a pop-up alarm clock setup menu.
- Click "Add alarm" to set the required time, ringtone, repeat cycle and alarm label etc.

#### File Browser

#### **Browse Files**

Click the application label, and then click to open the file browser. You can manage, edit, and delete files and folders in file browser.

## **Cut and Copy Files**

- In the file browser, long press the file you want to action.
- Pop-up action menu, which includes cut, paste, copy, delete, rename, new folder will appear.

## Click "Cut" or "copy"

- Enter the folder where you want to paste the file and long press the blank area for a pop-up menu window.
- Click "Paste"

#### **Delete files**

- In the file browser, long press the file you want to delete
- Click "Delete"
- Click OK to delete the file

## **Creating a New Folder**

- In the file browser, press the menu button popup menu.
- Click "New Folder"
- Pop-up window will open a text box
- Type the new folder name.
- Click OK to set up a folder.

#### Sound Recorder

Click the application label, open the sound recording application.
 Click to start Recording.

Click to stop and also decide to save or discard the file.
 Please use music player to play WAV recorded files.

You can click the application label to pop-up the application list, then click Settings to find settings interface



# Sound and Display

# **Media Volume Setting**

- Click on sound and display.
- Click on the media volume to adjust the volume of music and video.
- Bring up the volume settings panel, drag the progress bar to increase or decrease the volume

# **Adjust Screen Brightness**

- Click on sound and display.
- Scroll down the screen, click on brightness.
- The brightness panel will appear on screen.
  Adjust brightness by sliding between darker and brighter until desired level is achieved
- Click OK.

# **Adjust the Screen Timeout**

- Click on the sound and display.
- Scroll down the screen, then click on "Screen timeout".
- Select the time you require from the pop up screen.

#### Micro SD cards

## Manage and view Micro SD content

- Press the Menu key to access the pop-up settings menu.
- Click "Settings'.
- Click "SD card & device storage settings".
- View the available Micro SD card space.
- See the E-pad internal storage capacity.

## To remove the Micro SD card safely:

- In the home interface, press the Menu key to access pop-up settings menu.
- Click "Settings".
- Click "SD card & device storage settings".
- Click "Unmount SD card".
- Eject Micro SD card.

## **Restore factory settings**

If your device encounters a serious error or you forget your unlock password, you can reset your device back to the original factory settings. Restore factory settings means the deletion of downloaded applications and other user settings, so all data will be lost. Remember to back up your data

- In the home interface, press the Menu key to access the pop-up settings menu.
- · Click "Settings".
- Click "Privacy"
- Click "Factory Data Reset"
- The system will enter the erase data functions, the screen will be blank and the display black. After all data is deleted the system will automatically reboot

#### **Date and Time**

- Press the Menu key to access the pop-up settings menu.
- Click "Settings".
- Click "Date & Time"
- Click 'Set Date or Set Time"

## Set language

- n the home interface, press the Menu key pop-up settings menu.
- Click "Settings".
- Click on the "language & keyboard"
- Click "Select locale", and select the language you require. Scroll down the list to see more languages.

# 18 Install application



- Click on the application label, pop-up applications list.
- Select "App Installer", click "install", the program automatically scans all applications.
- Hold the apps you need to install
- Pop-up installation options, click "install".
- Follow the installation wizard to run after.

# **Uninstall application**

- In the home interface, press the Menu key to access the pop-up settings menu.
- · Click "Settings".
- Click "Applications".
- Click "Manage applications"; all the applications installed on the system will be listed.
- Choose the application and click "Uninstall".
- Click OK to complete uninstall.

# 19 Troubleshooting

## **Device cannot connect to your WIFI Network**

- Ensure your wireless router is turned on and working.
- Ensure the device and the wireless router are within a valid distance, and there are no walls or other obstructions between them.
- Ensure your user name and password is correct

# System freezes and doesn't work correctly after installation of applications

Installation of some applications may cause the system not to work correctly. You can press the reset button (next to power input port) to reset the system.

## **Unable to set up E-Mail Account**

- Ensure that the network is connected and you can connect to the Internet.
- Ensure your E-mail settings and passwords are correct.
  Data on the screen is corrupted or a program is not responding properly.
- Press and hold the Power Key about 8 seconds to restart.
